

## Notice of construction works, Oxford Canal Viaduct, Wormleighton

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. EKFB is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at [www.hs2innorthants.co.uk](http://www.hs2innorthants.co.uk).

### What are we doing?

In preparation for the construction of the Oxford Canal Viaduct, we will be reinforcing the canal bank by using a support method called sheet piling.

This involves driving interlocking metal sheets into the ground, to create a strong retaining wall between the viaduct and the waterside.

A small increase in noise may be experienced while this work is carried out, however we are using piling methods that reduce the noise impacts wherever possible.

### When will these works take place?

Works will be taking place by the Oxford Canal Viaduct site from Monday 25 September to Monday 16 October 2023. The work will be carried out during our normal working hours, Monday to Saturday.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather. This work is subject to local authority consents and approvals.

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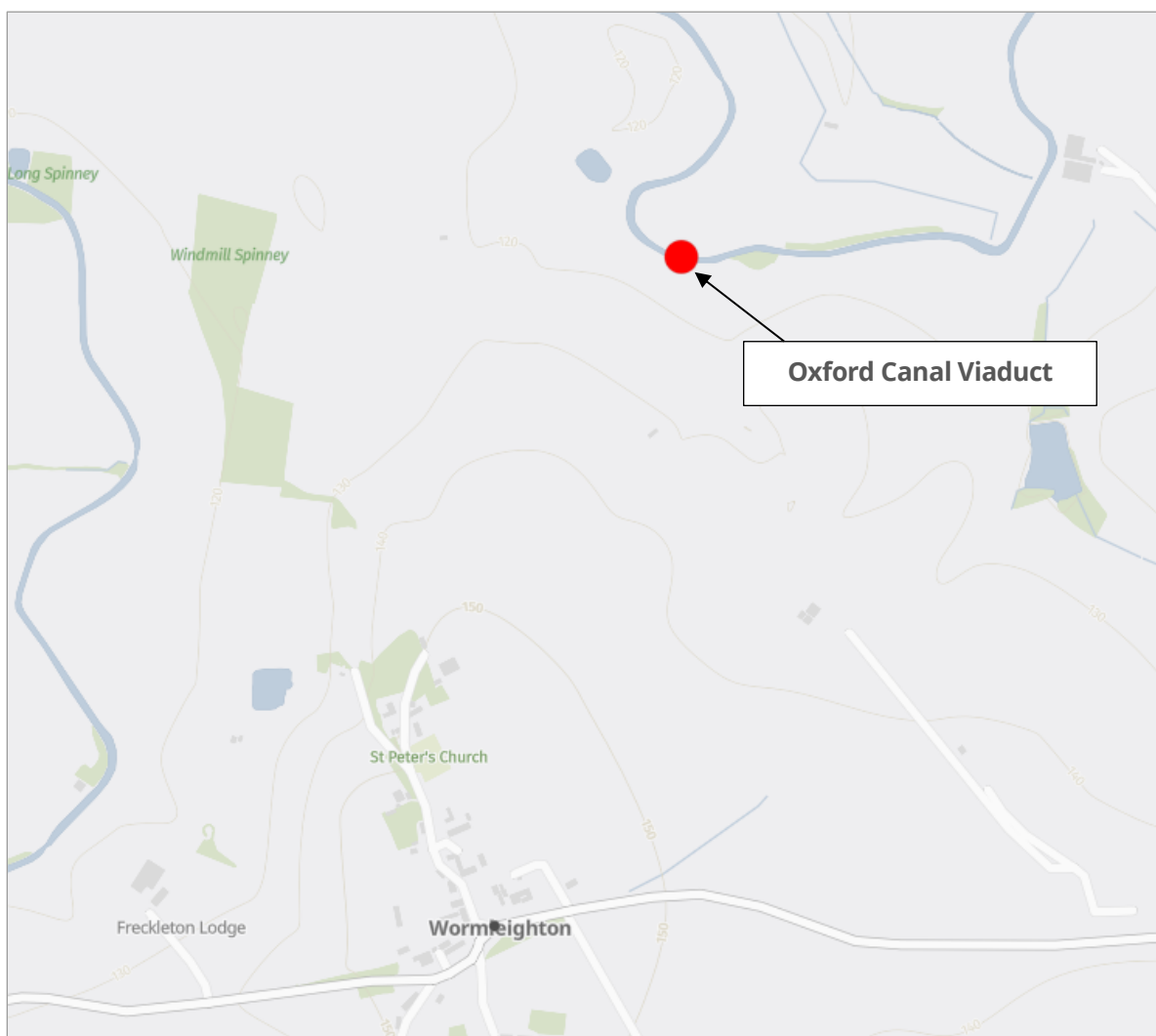
