This look ahead covers HS2 associated work in Brent and Ealing on our four vent shafts. For information around Old Oak Common station, please see our Old Oak and North Acton look ahead.

The document includes:

- A forward look of construction activities planned in the next three months; and
- Works to be aware of that will take place in the next 12 months, but may not yet have been confirmed.

Map 1 - Canterbury Works Vent Shaft, Kilburn



Some of our work at this site may require extended hours of working. If extended working hours are required, we will inform the local community in advance.

We are pausing and rephasing some construction activities between Euston and Old Oak Common. This includes activities at the Canterbury Works headhouse and ventilation shaft site, which will be brought to a safe stop in spring 2024 until spring 2025.



Location 1 Canterbury Works site	Winter 2023 to autumn 2024	 Works planned at our Canterbury Works site during this period include: Ongoing works to build the ventilation shaft including excavation and installation of a sprayed concrete lining; Works to build adits (horizontal passages below ground) that will connect the HS2 tunnels. These include excavation, waterproofing and concrete lining works; and Works to install the base slab, secondary lining and waterproofing in the ventilation shaft. In spring 2024 site activities will be brought to a safe pause until spring 2025, in line with Government direction.

The surveys help us to understand how we may need to protect utility services and bridges during construction of the tunnels. We may need to carry out utility protection works and bridge protection works in some local areas in Brent, including:

We will carry out utility and bridge surveys in various locations along the HS2 tunnel route. The surveys help us to understand how we may need to protect utility services and bridges during construction of the tunnels.

We may need to carry out utility protection works and structural bridge mitigations near our Westgate site.

We currently expect that utility protection works will be required in:

- West Gate
- Alperton Lane
- Western Avenue

We are planning to carry out utility works on Lynwood Road from winter 2023/24.

Further details and dates for any utility and bridge protection works remain subject to ongoing surveys and design work.

Location 1 Greenpark Way site	September to November 2023	 Ongoing works at our Greenpark Way site during this period include: Works to build the main ventilation shaft and satellite shaft including excavation, installation of concrete segments and a sprayed construction lining and construction of the concrete foundation, known as a base slab;

		 Removal of water from the ground as the shaft is constructed;
		Network Rail track maintenance works every three months;
		Piling activities for the headhouse foundation; and
		Sheet piling activities for construction of the ventilation basement, which will be used to manage the air quality once the tunnels have been constructed. Sheet piling is the process of driving metal sheets into the ground to create an additional layer of support.

The surveys will tell us what work is needed to protect utility services during construction of the tunnels. We may need to carry out utility protection works in some local areas in Ealing.

		Works to build sprayed concrete lining adits (horizontal passages) that will connect the HS2 tunnels; and
		Start of preparation works to build the headhouse building (the building that sits on top of the ventilation shaft). These works will include installation of a concrete foundation, known as a base slab, and piling.
Various locations, Ealing	Winter 2023 to autumn 2024	We will continue to carry out utility and bridge surveys in various locations along the HS2 tunnel route. The surveys will inform future works to protect these assets during construction of the tunnels.
		We may need to carry out some utility protection works and structural bridge mitigations near our Greenpark Way site.
		We currently expect that utility protection works may be required in Bideford Avenue.
		Further details and dates for any utility and bridge protection works remain subject to ongoing surveys and design work.
		We will write to you in advance of any utility surveys or utility works that might impact you.

Location 1 Mandeville Road site	September to November 2023	 Works on our Mandeville Road site during this period include: Sheet piling for the satellite shaft: this is the process of driving metal sheets into the ground to create an additional layer of support around the walls of the shaft; Reinforced concrete works to the main shaft and satellite shaft with some extended working hours to facilitate concrete pours; and Excavation of the satellite shaft and installation of sprayed concrete lining.

Location 3 Eastcote Lane	Summer 2024	Surveys of the road following the progress of our tunnel boring machines under Eastcote Lane.
Greenford Road, Greenford	Summer 2024	Surveys of the road following the progress of our tunnel boring machines under Greenford Road.
Oldfield Lane North, Greenford	January to May 2024	Utility works on Oldfield Lane North during this period include: Excavation works; Replacement of the gas mains; and Reinstatement of the site.

- We have local community teams who know your area. They will hold local events and run projects to keep you informed.

Involving

- We will involve you in opportunities to benefit and learn as we build HS2 including jobs, skills, education, employment and funding.
- We will ask you about the design of specific parts of the railway.

Responding

- Our dedicated HS2 Helpdesk is available 24 hours a day, every day of the year, to help with any questions or concerns you have about HS2 or our work.
- If things go wrong, we have a complaints process and a dedicated complaints team.
- An independent Construction Commissioner monitors how we manage and deal with complaints.

Consulting

- We will hold formal consultations with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b of HS2.
- We now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a. This means we will only formally consult on this part of HS2 when we need permission to do things that fall outside the terms of the legislation agreed by Parliament.

Keeping you informed

We are committed to keeping you informed about work on HS2. This includes ensuring you know what to expect and when to expect it, as well as how we can help.
