High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be completing

We are continuing to prepare for works to construct the Coleshill Viaducts that will carry the HS2 railway over the existing B4114 Birmingham Road. As part of this, we will complete works to install utilities along a section of the B4114 Birmingham Road.

Traffic management

To complete the works safely, we will install a four-week closure to the road. This will be in place from Monday 30 October until Friday 24 November. Access to pedestrians and residents will be maintained throughout the works and a clear diversion route will be in place at all times. The closure and diversion route is shown on page two.


