High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What we are doing

We will be undertaking utility works on Greenford Road to install a new gas main from **24 September 2023 to 18 March 2024**. This work is in preparation for our Tunnel Boring Machines to pass through the area.

The junctions of Bennetts Avenue and Uneeda Drive on either side of Greenford Road will be closed there will be a temporary work site in this area. Clearly signposted diversion routes will be in place. Please see the map overleaf showing the location of the works.

On Greenford Road traffic management with a lane closure and temporary traffic lights will be in place 24 hours a day throughout these works.

The working hours will be Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm and Saturdays 8am to 6pm. No noisy works will take place after 1pm on Saturdays.

The works will pause on 4 December 2023 until Monday 8 January **2024** over the Christmas period. We will send you monthly newsletters to keep you updated on the progress of these works. We will also be holding monthly pop-up events where you can speak to us directly and ask any questions you may have. We will provide more detail on these events in the newsletters which will be posted through your door.

What to expect

Temporary work site on Bennetts Avenue and lane closure on Greenford Road

Noisier works during excavation. We will use an excavator with breaker attachment to break out the concrete, and an excavation vacuum to remove waste material.

Traffic management with a lane closure and temporary traffic lights will be in place 24 hours a day during these works

What we will do

Maintain access for pedestrians

Use noise reducing barriers around areas where we are digging and drilling

How these works might affect you

We will be using an excavation vacuum to remove the soil during these works, and we expect that this will create some noise. We will restrict the use of this equipment as much as possible and install noise reducing barriers to minimise the impact this might have on residents.

Some parking bays on Greenford Road will be suspended and driveway access restricted due to the works. Residents will be contacted directly if they are amongst those affected.

We would like to apologise in advance for the disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way possible.
