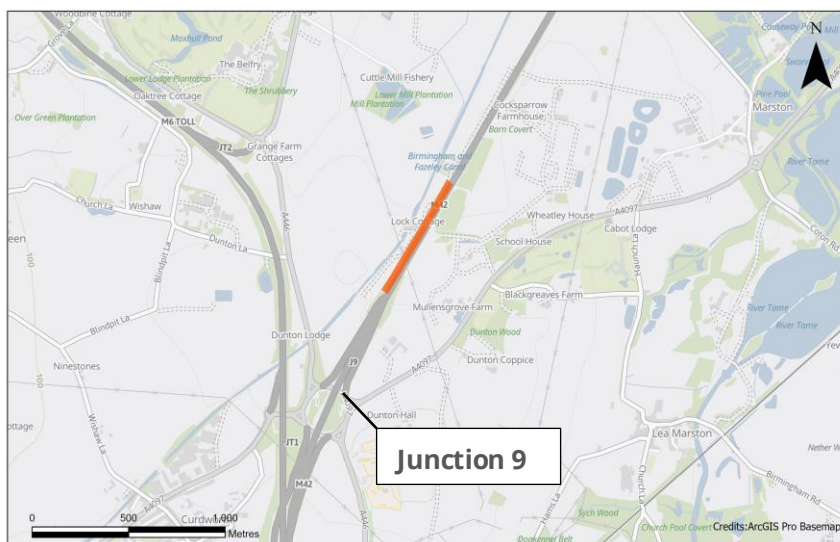
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We will be continuing works on the Marston Box bridge which was installed in early 2023. We will be constructing abutments, between the deck and the ground at each end of the structure, that will support the bridge. To commence piling works on the abutments we will extend and widen a haul road to allow the safe passage of plant vehicles and machinery. To complete these works safely we will close a section of hard shoulder on the M42 motorway northbound carriageway between junction 9 to 10.

When the works will take place

We will close a section of hard shoulder from 16 October to early December 2023. Our working hours over this period will be 9.30am to 3.30pm (Mon-Fri).

Duration of works

Temporary closure of a section of the northbound carriageway hard shoulder on the M42 motorway, between junctions 9 to 10, from 16 October to early December 2023.
