Notice of closure, Helmdon Road, Greatworth and footpath AN13

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

To construct the Greatworth Green Tunnel we will be closing a section of Helmdon Road, Greatworth. The closure area is from beyond the properties on Helmdon Road to the B4525 and will last for approximately two years.

We will create a turning area for local traffic just before the closure area.

Our initial work will be to divert the nearby overhead power cables. The complex network of cables, which run over Helmdon Road and our construction area, will be moved underground.

There will also be a short period of traffic lights on the B4525 where it joins Helmdon Road.

Once the power cable division work has been completed we will begin the excavation and construction for the green tunnel. On completion, Helmdon Road will be re-instated as a new road over the green tunnel.

During this time the footpath knowns as AN13, will be closed where it crosses the construction area. Access through the area is provided by the diversion of footpath AN14. Please see the map on page 3 for details.

When will these works take place?

- Helmdon Road will be closed from 2 October 2023 until the completion of the Greatworth Green Tunnel and road realignment at the end of 2025.
- Traffic lights on the B4525 from 2 to 14 October 2023.
- PRoW footpath AN13 will close from 2 October until the completion of the Greatworth Green Tunnel at the end of 2025.

These works are subject to local authority consents and permissions.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.


Notice of road closure, Helmdon Road, Greatworth

The closure area is beyond the village boundary north of properties on Helmdon Road to the B4525.




Notice of closure, Public Right of Way, AN13, Greatworth
