



# **Notice of traffic management** A418 Oxford Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. If you have any questions or enquiries about our work, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

#### What are we doing?

Throughout 2023, the Princes Risborough to Aylesbury (PRA) team will continue works to prepare for a 10-week closure known as a blockade.

The blockade is a closure of the existing railway line to allow for major works to be carried out. This is planned to be between Saturday 19 August and Monday 30 October 2023.

Ahead of these works, there will be traffic management on the A418 Oxford Road. There will be traffic management in the form of a crossing point, which will facilitate the transport of essential aggregate materials to the PRA work site.

The crossing point will be manually controlled by an operative on the ground and priority will be given to road users. The traffic management will be monitored to assess the impact on the highway.



# When will these works take place?

Traffic management will be in place on the A418 Oxford Road from Saturday 2 September to Tuesday 5 September 2023 from 8am to 6pm.

Please note; this traffic management is only in place to bring aggregate across the A418 during this period and will be removed when complete.

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

Wherever possible, we will minimise the impact on highway users by coordinating deliveries to avoid peak times.

Provide updates for communities and maintain regular contact with emergency services.


