High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

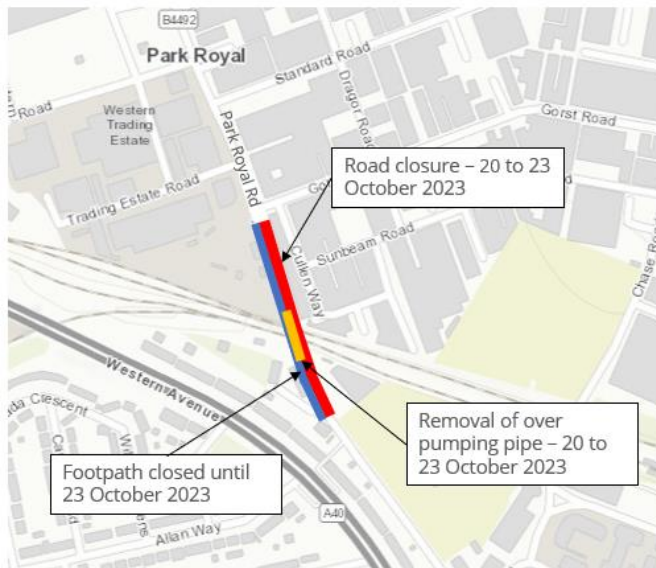
Removal of over pumping pipe on Park Royal Road

From **Friday 20 to Monday 23 October 2023**, we will be carrying out works to remove an over pumping pipe, situated above ground on Park Royal Road. This pipe is no longer required as the sewer lining works are now complete.

How might this affect you?

To ensure the safety of our operatives and the public **we will be closing Park Royal Road on Friday 20 October from 10pm until 5am on Monday 23 October 2023**. The footpath will also be closed during these works.
