High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Works on the Guinness Bridge and Piccadilly Line Overbridge

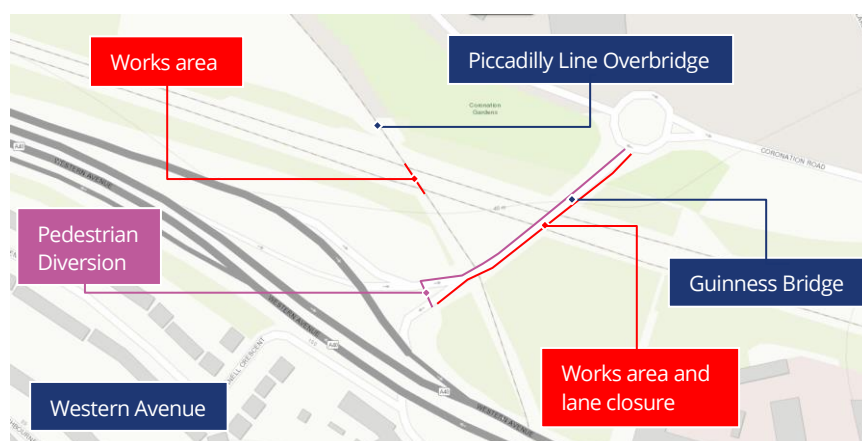
From **30 October 2023 to 30 June 2024** we will be carrying out works to protect the Guinness Bridge and Piccadilly Line Overbridge on Western Avenue.

The works will take place between **7am and 7pm Monday to Sunday**. **Traffic management will be in place 24 hours**. We will use noise reducing barriers where possible to help minimise any noise disruption to the local community, working as efficiently as possible whilst keeping our work areas safe and tidy.

The works will involve putting up scaffolding, jacking the bridge and replacing bearings and bearing plates ahead of the Tunnel Boring Machines (TBM) passing this area.

What to expect

To ensure the safety of the public and our staff, temporary changes will be in place on Guinness Bridge including lane closure and pedestrian diversion. Two-way traffic flow will be maintained. No traffic management will be required in relation to the Piccadilly Line Overbridge.
