



Notice of road closure, Wormleighton Road, Boddington

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. EKFB is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

On the border between Warwickshire and West Northamptonshire, we have been building a new road bridge, as well as new sections of highway within our construction area. Once open, these will enable local roads to pass over the HS2 railway line.

Since August, Banbury Road near Boddington has been closed while we connect it to our recently constructed Banbury Road Overbridge.

In late October, there will be an additional road closure of Wormleighton Road. The work involves raising the height of Wormleighton Road and connecting it to a new section of highway.

During the closure road surfacing, white lining and the installation of road signage will also be completed. It will not be safe or practical to keep the road open while this work is in progress.

When Wormleighton Road re-opens, users will find a new road layout that passes over the new Banbury Road Overbridge. Some temporary traffic lights will be required on this bridge when it first opens. These traffic lights will be removed once all the permanent features of the bridge are installed.

When will these works take place?

A section of both Wormleighton Road and Banbury Road will be fully closed, 24-hours a day, from Monday 23 October to late November 2023. In order to minimise the closure period, we may slightly delay the start date to better coincide with the ongoing highway construction in the area, and we will update you further if this is the case.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather. This work is subject to local authority consents and approvals.

Duration of works

A section of Wormleighton Road will be fully closed from Monday 23 October to late November 2023.

24-7 full road closure.

What to expect

Closure of a section of Wormleighton Road into November while we carry out works for the new road realignment.

Noise from plant and machinery. Some weekend and evening work may be required.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

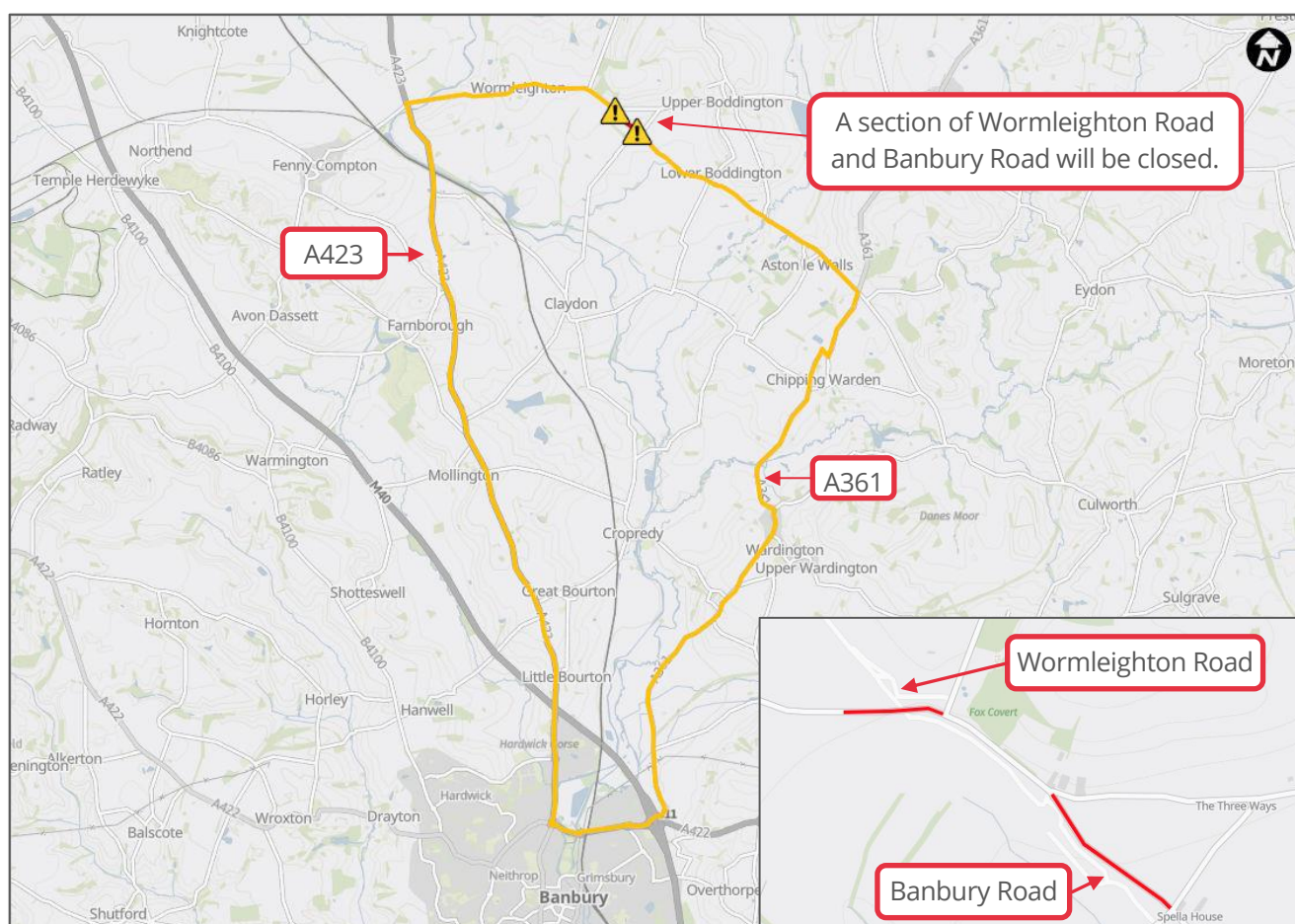

Where will the works take place?

The map below shows the section of Wormington Road that will be fully closed 24-hours a day, from Monday 23 October until late November 2023. As well as a section of Banbury Road, also closed until late November 2023.

From 23 October to late November 2023:

- Banbury Road and Wormleighton Road will both be closed.
- At the junction with Stoneton Lane (also known as Leisure Drive) vehicles will only be able to turn left, and head along Warwick Road towards Upper Boddington.



From late November 2023:

- Banbury Road and Wormleighton Road will be open with traffic passing over the new Banbury Road Overbridge.
- Initially the bridge will open for single lane traffic, controlled by temporary traffic lights.

From late 2023/early 2024:

- Warwick Road will be closed for approximately 1 month
- Stoneton Lane will be closed to excavate the cutting and build a new Green Overbridge for approximately 18-24 months.
