High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will complete

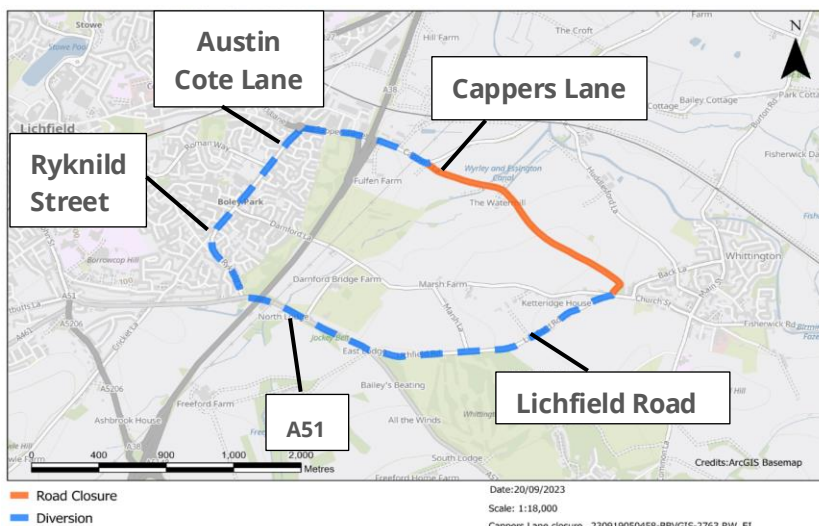
We will be undertaking works to upgrade the existing road surface along a section of Cappers Lane. These works will include resurfacing approximately 100 metres of carriageway and installing white lines.

When the work will take place

We will close a section of Cappers Lane on 30 October 2023. The road will be closed from 7am to 7pm. If we are unable to complete these works on this date, we will use a contingency day, and close Cappers Lane on 31 October 2023 between 7am to 7pm.

Where we will be working

The map below details the road closure and the signed diversion route.

Duration of works

Temporary closure of a section of Cappers Lane on 30 October 2023.

Contingency day, if required, will be 31 October 2023.

The closure will be in place from 7am to 7pm.
