Notice of road closures update, Chetwode

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inbucksandox.co.uk.

What are we doing?

As part of our continued preparatory works for the School End Overbridge and new road realignment, it is necessary to remove remaining tree stumps to enable future works to continue and to allow access to areas of the site. These works are essential before the nesting season begins.

To carry out these works we need a daytime road closure of a section of Stratton Audley Road, by School End. We will also need a daytime road closure of the Chetwode Grange Road.

Access for residences and businesses within the closure areas will be maintained.

When will these works take place?

A section of Stratton Audley Road will be fully closed during the day between 9am and 3pm from Monday 13 November to Friday 17 November 2023, with a diversion route in place.

A section of Chetwode Grange Road will be fully closed during the day between 9am and 3pm from Monday 13 November to Friday 17 November 2023, with a diversion route in place.

We will work to reopen the roads as soon as possible, to reduce disruption. Access will be maintained for emergency services.

Take care to respect the community.


