High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

What are we doing?

Last year we temporarily closed and diverted sections of Public Rights of Way (PRoW) between Godington, Preston Bissett and Twyford.

As part of our continued work in the area, it is now necessary to temporarily close a section of bridleway known as CHW/24 as well as a section of PRoW 225/4. This closure is required due to the excavation for the Godington Viaduct.

For the safety of pedestrians and our staff, we must fully close these sections of PRoWs. Signage on the footpath will indicate the closure.

When will these works take place?

A section of the bridleway known as CHW/24 as well as a section of PRoW 225/4 will be closed, 24 hours a day, and will remain closed for approximately three years from Wednesday 18 October 2023.

Duration of works

Sections of the Public Right of Ways known as CHW/24 and 225/4 will be closed from Wednesday 18 October until early 2026.

What to expect

PRoW closures for approximately 3 years.

Noise from plant and equipment used for the earthworks.

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.


