What are we doing?

In November EKFB will continue work to divert utilities for the permanent realignment of the A423 Banbury Road and the construction of the Banbury Road Overbridge.

Working with utility suppliers, we will be installing a new power cable connection under the road. To complete this, a section of the A423, near our construction area, will be closed for 2 days.

We will also be carrying out some work in the roadside verges in November and early December. In order for our workforce to carry out their work safely, there will be short periods of lane closures. The exact location of the lane closure will vary as work progresses and will be controlled by temporary traffic lights.

When will these works take place?

- A section of the A423 Banbury Road between Ladbroke and Southam will be closed from 6am on Saturday 11 November to 6am on Monday 13 November 2023.
- Traffic lights on sections of the A423 Banbury Road between Ladbroke and Southam, 21 November, 2 December and 4 to 9 December 2023.

These dates may be subject to change, due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather. This work is subject to local authority consents and approvals.

Duration of works

A section of the A423 will be closed from 6am on Saturday 11 November to 6am on Monday 13 November 2023

The A423 will have short periods of lane closures controlled by traffic lights on 21 November, 2 December and 4 to 9 December 2023.

Hours of Work: Monday to Saturday 8.30am-5.30pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.



Notice of traffic management, A423, Southam




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Where will the works take place?
