What we are doing

We wrote to you in October to let you know that we would be carrying out utility and construction activities to build and finalise the connection sections for the Harvil Road realignment from 23 October to 19 November.

We have rearranged these dates and the works will now take place from **30 October to 12 November 2023**.

We will be carrying out the utility water main connection only under a northbound lane closure, between the Dogs Trust and our site entrance (gate 2).

We would like to apologise in advance for any disruption or inconvenience the lane closure may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way.

Keep disruption to a minimum

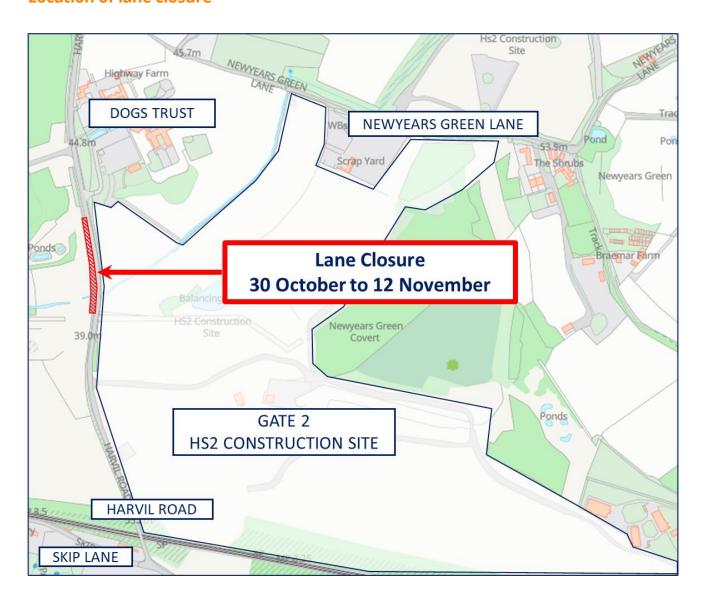
