Notice of traffic lights on A425 Leamington Road and B4451 Kineton Road, Southam

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inwarwickshire.co.uk.

What are we doing?

Kineton Road: EKFB are putting up a fence along the roadside near where the new bridge will eventually join the highway, to complete this work safely there will be traffic management in the form of a single lane closure with two-way traffic lights for approximately 3 days.

A425 Learning ton Road: EKFB are building a permanent road for maintenance access to the railway along the A425 Learnington Road in Southam.

During late November we will be carrying out some de-vegetation and preparation works for a new access road.

To carry out these works, the A425 will have traffic management in the form of a single lane closure with two-way traffic lights for approximately 2 days.

When will these works take place?

- A short section of B4451 Kineton Road will have traffic management from Monday 27 November to Wednesday 29 November 2023, from 8am to 4pm.
- A short section of the A425 Leamington Road will have traffic management from Thursday 30 November to Friday 1 December 2023, from 8am to 4pm.

These dates may be subject to local authority consents and may change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Access will be maintained for residents as well as emergency services within the closure area.


Notice of traffic lights on B4451 Kineton Road, Southam
