



Notice of single lane closure on A412, near Denham Waterski Club

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This notice is to inform you of a single lane closure of the A412 northbound (towards Maple Cross) for survey trial holes and utility surveys in land west of the highway.

Overnight lane closure managed by temporary traffic lights

We will be undertaking survey trial holes to inform us of the design needed for the new access for the Public Right of Way (PROW) – DEN/3 from the A412 onto the western slopes. To manage these works safely we will need to close the northbound lane of the A412. Some noise may be heard during the works while we excavate the soil. The soil will be taken away by HGVs. To reduce noise, we will place acoustic screening around the works. The surveys will take place overnight for four nights from Monday 27 November 2023 between 9pm and 6am. A map of the traffic management is below.
