Notice of full weekend road closures, A43 and Radstone Road, Brackley

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inbucksandox.co.uk.

What are we doing?

This spring, we began constructing a temporary diversion of a short section of the A43 in both directions, running alongside the existing A43, near Brackley. This diversion is required so that we can build the new A43 Overbridge that will carry traffic over the HS2 railway line.

We are now ready to complete the tie in works that will join the new temporary road to the existing A43. These works will include the installation of drainage, lighting, signage, resurfacing and white lining. For reasons of safety, these works will require full weekend closures. These works are subject to consent.

Our works will also involve temporarily closing a section of the Radstone Road, Radstone (the section of road between Radstone and the A43) to carry out remedial works to the Radstone Road junction.

When will these works take place?

A section of the **A43 Northbound**, towards Northampton, will be fully closed, 24-hours a day, from 8pm Friday 8 December to 6am Monday 11 December. Once this work is completed, there will be a temporary diversion running alongside the existing A43 northbound for about a mile.

A section of the Radstone Road, also known as Whitfield Road, Radstone will also be fully closed during the full weekend closure detailed above. There will be no access from the Radstone Road junction onto the A43.

Duration of works

A section of the **A43 Northbound** towards

What to expect

Full weekend closure of a section of the A43 in December to tie in the new temporary diversion.

We would remind all road users to plan their journeys, allow more time and follow the signed diversion routes.

The temporary diversions will be in place until the new A43 overbridge becomes operational in 2025.

A 50mph speed limit will be in force along these diversions, this is for the safety of both road users and our workforce.



Where will the works take place?

The map below, shows the approximate closure area on the A43, between Turweston and Westbury. It also shows the temporary diversion for the Radstone Road, Radstone with further details on the following page. We understand there may be shorter diversions, but we are obligated to share a diversion with like for like roads.

In addition to this notice, the road closure information will also be communicated through traditional road signage as well as electronic signage. These signs will be located in strategic locations and placed in a safe location.






