



One night closure of Moorhall Road, Hillingdon

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Align JV is building the Colne Valley Viaduct, which has now crossed Moorhall Road in Hillingdon.

What works need to take place?

The Colne Valley Viaduct crossed Moorhall Road in August this year. We now need to install some safety railing on either side of the viaduct. To ensure this work is done safely we will need to close Moorhall Road at the location of the viaduct, between the River Garden Public House and the junction with Link Way and Savay Lane. Access will be maintained for residents. The public footpath will remain open with some minor diversions. The closure is early in the morning of Wednesday 3 January 2024 between 1am and 5am. Below is a picture of the vehicle diversion route.
