The document includes:


- A forward look of construction activities planned in the next three months.

Three-month look ahead

| Location of works | Proposed duration | Description of works |

| Location 1 Warwickshire border | February to April 2024 | Construction of a new section of road, connecting Wormleighton Road to a new road bridge. This will require the closure of Wormleighton Road for approximately four weeks; and |
| | | Realignment of Warwick Road, near Boddington, to connect the highway to a new |

| | | road bridge. This will require a six-week closure in March. |

| | March 2024 to 2026 | Closure of Stoneton Lane, Priors Hardwick, to construct the Stoneton Lane green overbridge. |
| Location 2 Lower Boddington | Ongoing to late 2024 | Closure of Claydon Road for the construction of the Claydon Road overbridge. The foundations are now complete, and work will start on the main structure; and Some changes to the diversion of the Millennium Way footpath may be required where this path crosses our construction area. |
| | Ongoing to late 2024 | Continuation of main earthworks activities including stockpiling of material from the Chipping Warden green tunnel; and Continued construction of the Highfurlong viaduct, including the installation of the parapets. |
| Location 3 Aston Le Walls | Continuing through 2024 | Excavation of the Chipping Warden green tunnel, including the installation of precast tunnel sections, to form the structure of the tunnel. |
| Location 4 Chipping Warden | Continuing through to 2024 | Continued construction of the Chipping Warden green tunnel; Construction of a new section of highway, realigning the A361 over the Chipping Warden green tunnel; and On-going delivery of pre-cast segments to our compound, requiring the occasional use of traffic management on the A361. |

| Location 1 Halse Copse | Ongoing throughout winter 2023-24 | Excavation of the deep railway cutting continues with material transported using the internal access road up to Greatworth; and |
| | | Greatworth earthworks to restart in early 2024, north of the AN14 bridleway, including soil stripping and roman well excavation (subject to consents). |

| Location 2 Radstone | Ongoing throughout winter 2023-24 | Preparatory works for the temporary diversion of Radstone Road to build the overbridge this winter; Construction on abutments, wing walls and other structural elements of the Radstone Road overbridge and adjacent accommodation overbridge; and Excavation of the deep railway cutting continues, including movement and storage of earth. |
|------------------------|---|---|
| Location 3 A43 | Ongoing throughout winter 2023-24 | Final works for the A43 temporary diversion: asphalting, white lining and the installation of road signage; Full weekend road closures of the A43 to tie in the new temporary diversion; and Foundation works including sheet piling activities to start for the A43 overbridge. |
| Location 4 A422 | Ongoing throughout winter 2023-24 | Works on final utility diversions; Works for the permanent realignment and new overbridge for the A422; Earthwork activities including excavation and the creation of embankments for the Westbury viaduct; and Piling works to start in early 2024. |

Informing

- We will tell you about HS2 works in your area.
- We have local community websites and newsletters with regular information and updates about our work in your area.
- We have local community teams who know your area. They will hold local events and run projects to keep you informed.

Involving

- We will involve you in opportunities to benefit and learn as we build HS2 including jobs, skills, education, employment and funding.
- We will ask you about the design of specific parts of the railway.

Responding

- Our dedicated HS2 Helpdesk is available 24 hours a day, every day of the year, to help with any questions or concerns you have about HS2 or our work.
- If things go wrong, we have a complaints process and a dedicated complaints team.
- An independent Construction Commissioner monitors how we manage and deal with complaints.

Consulting

- We will hold formal consultations with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b of HS2.
- We now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a. This means we will only
 formally consult on this part of HS2 when we need permission to do things that fall
 outside the terms of the legislation agreed by Parliament.

We are committed to keeping you informed about work on HS2. This includes ensuring you know what to expect and when to expect it, as well as how we can help.
