
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As part of our continued work to construct HS2, Balfour Beatty Vinci (BBV) will be completing a considerable amount of work along the M42, M6 Toll and M42 M6 link road, in areas near Water Orton and Coleshill over the next three years. This will include enabling works and the construction of three structures that will span the strategic road network. These structures are the M42 M6 Link Road Viaducts, that will carry the HS2 railway over the M42 M6 link road and the Water Orton Viaducts and Coleshill Triple Box Structure, that will both carry the HS2 railway over the M42 and M6 toll.

Traffic management

In order to continue works on the Water Orton Viaducts, BBV will install long term traffic management along areas of the M42 M6 link road and the M42 and M6 Toll. This will provide the space needed for us to work safely next to the motorway to complete the construction of the piers. To install the long-term traffic management, we will put in place two phases of overnight temporary traffic management for short periods, this is outlined on page 2 and 3.



Duration of works

Long term traffic management to be installed along M42, M6 Toll and M42 M6 link road

Overnight closure on M42 M6 link road eastbound from 29 January until 1 February

Overnight closure on M42 and M6 Toll southbound from 5 to 10 February

What to expect

Overnight closures to take place from 9.00pm until 5.00am each night

Clear signage to be in place for closure, diversion and long-term traffic management



Phase 1 – M42 M6 link road eastbound overnight closures and M42, M6 Toll overnight northbound lane closures

The first phase of traffic management will include an overnight closure of M42 M6 link road eastbound from 9.00pm until 5.00am each night, from Monday 29 January until Thursday 1 February 2024. This is shown in orange on the map below. The diversion route is shown in blue, it will follow the M6, A446 and A452 southbound, where road users will then follow the A45 to re-join the M42 at junction 6.

There will be a short section of northbound lane closures along M42 and M6 Toll, throughout the closure and diversion. The lane closures will leave one lane open throughout and the location of this is shown in black on the map below.



Phase 2 – M42 M6 link road westbound overnight closures and M42, M6 Toll overnight southbound closures

Following this, the second phase of overnight closures will be on the southbound carriageway of M42 and M6 Toll and the westbound carriageway of M42 M6 Link Road. The closure will take place from 9.00pm until 5.00am each night, for 5 nights from Monday 5 to Saturday 10 February, the location of this is shown in orange on the map below. The diversion route is shown in blue, it will follow A446 southbound where road users will be able to join the M6 or follow the A452 and A45 to re-join the M42 at junction 6.
