Notice of night time road closure, A361, Chipping Warden

Notification

What are we doing?

In 2022 we installed a temporary bridge over the A361 near Chipping Warden. This has significantly reduced our impact on the local road network, providing a safe route for our heavy plant to cross the A361 without interfering with highway traffic.

Due to the effects of the winter weather, some routine maintenance is now required. To carry out this work safely, in February 2024 we will be closing the A361, at the weekend, for two nights. The progress of the maintenance required may be affected by weather conditions, therefore we planned for an additional overnight weekend closure as a contingency.

We will also be carrying out trail hole utility surveys of the A361 during the same closure period. These surveys are in preparation for the realignment of the A361 over the Chipping Warden Green Tunnel. Work on this realignment will continue throughout 2024 and some additional traffic management will be required later this year.

Wherever possible we will keep noise to a minimum, however some of our equipment may create noise which, due to the time of night, is more noticeable than usual.

When will these works take place?

A section of the A361 Byfield Road will be closed overnight on Friday 9 February and Saturday 10 February, from 8.30pm and 5.30am.

As a contingency, we may also need to close the road on Friday 16 February and Saturday 17 February, from 8.30pm and 5.30am.
