High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What we are doing

As part of our ongoing utility works to re-line the gas main on Greenford Road, we will need to remove two lampposts overnight on **Friday 26 January between 10pm and 3am**.

How these works might affect you

The existing traffic management with a lane closure and temporary traffic lights will remain in place on Greenford Road 24 hours a day for the duration of our utility works.

We will be removing the two lampposts using a small elevated mobile platform. This machine will be parked in the road and the existing traffic lights will be adjusted to fit around the machinery during this time.

These works will take about 2-3 hours to complete.

Night- time works to remove two lamp columns. Elevated mobile platform and a lorry will be used Operators present during the works

Maintain access for pedestrians. Keep noise to a minimum


