Notice of extension to Ellesborough **Road closure for temporary** realignment tie-in

What are we doing?

During the last 4 weeks, we have been completing tie in works to join the new alignment of Ellesborough Road into the existing carriageway.

During the course of these complex realignment works, our team have so far constructed and resurfaced the tie in points, installed safety barriers and worked with our partners to redirect utilities.

Due to circumstances beyond our control, the high voltage electricity cable situated above the new alignment was not able to be realigned during this closure period.

Due to strike risk caused by the low height of the cable, which is situated above the new alignment, we are unable to open the road as planned on the 18th of February. The original alignment is currently not in a condition to allow traffic to pass safely along it, therefore the closure of Ellesborough Road will need to be extended, whilst we manage the removal of this cable and reinstall a vehicle restraint system along the original alignment. This will allow us to utilise the original alignment should there be a delay in the cable removal.

Pedestrian and resident access will be maintained throughout the closure although the footpath maybe diverted onto the carriageway.

Ellesborough Road must be diverted to continue with the construction of Wendover Green Tunnel and to enable us to move excavated materials around the site without impact the road network. The diversion includes a temporary new bridge which will enable road users to pass over our site.

When will these works take place?

Saturday 24th 2024 to Wednesday 28th February 2024.

Please note, these dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but will be completed on or around the timings specified.

Should our team finish earlier than planned, we will open the road when practicable.

Manage any noise or traffic impacts.



Where will the road closure be?

The map below shows the road closure and diversion route that will be in operation during the closure. Our works will be contained within the closed red section below.

How will this affect me?

For the advised dates, road users are being provided with a fully signposted diversion route. We would suggest allowing for additional journey time during this period. For residents, full access is being provided for properties along the road.

A pedestrian walking route will also be maintained, cyclists and those on horseback will have access but should dismount before passing through the works area. Those bringing horses through should be aware that some of these works may be noisy.

What will the Ellesborough Road re-alignment be like?

The newly diverted road will go around the back of the existing houses on Ellesborough Road and will include a temporary bridge which allows our site traffic to pass underneath.

Bacombe Lane is also being temporary realigned with new access from Ellesborough Road. The access is due to be opened in the Spring of 2024. Once the new access has been opened, the original access point from South Street/London Road will be temporarily closed, there will be no through route.

As both realignments are temporary, they will eventually be removed and the area landscaped towards the end of the project. Their original alignments will be reinstated with slight amendments to take the road over the Wendover Green Tunnel.

Will there be any more closures?

We are trying to condense these closures as much as possible to reduce inconvenience however we require the support of the utility companies as the assets owners. It is difficult to coordinate the utility companies to attend the site at the same time which is why there are different closures taking place for utility diversions.

There will be further road closures to complete the tie-in of Ellesborough Road and to allow us to tie in the Bacombe Lane diversion. This is due to be operational in the Spring of 2024. We will also need to undertake surveys and maintenance of the temporary bridge periodically which may require temporary traffic management.

Further short duration road closures may also be required for the construction of the Green Tunnel, details of this will be communicated closer to the time.
