High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

School Road Sewer Lining Works

From 4 to 11 March 2024, we will be using machinery to lift and insert a new liner into the existing sewer system.

By 23 February 2024, we will have inserted the first section of the liner via a manhole on our Flat Iron site in preparation for the second phase of works which will take place on School Road.

Temporary traffic management changes will be in place on School Road during these works.

These works will take place overnight, between 7pm and 7am, Monday to Sunday.

We do not expect these works to cause any major noise disruption.

However, we will use noise reducing barriers where possible, to help minimise any disruption to the local community and work as efficiently as possible whilst keeping our work areas safe and tidy.

How this might affect you

To ensure the safety of the public and our staff, temporary traffic management changes will be in place overnight on School Road. A temporary Lane closure and parking bay suspensions will be in place; however you will still be able to drive along School Road.

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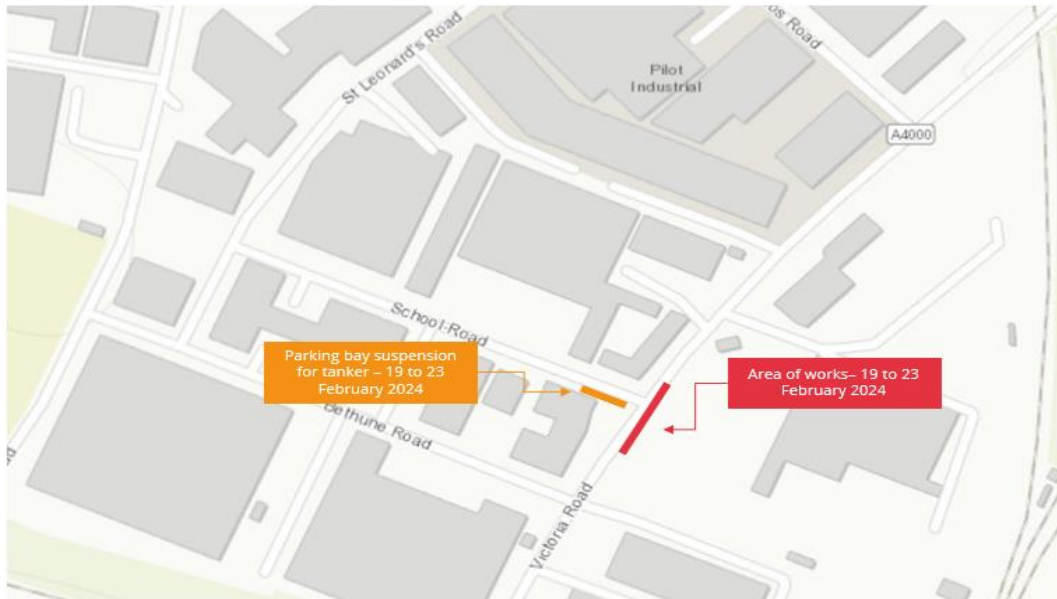

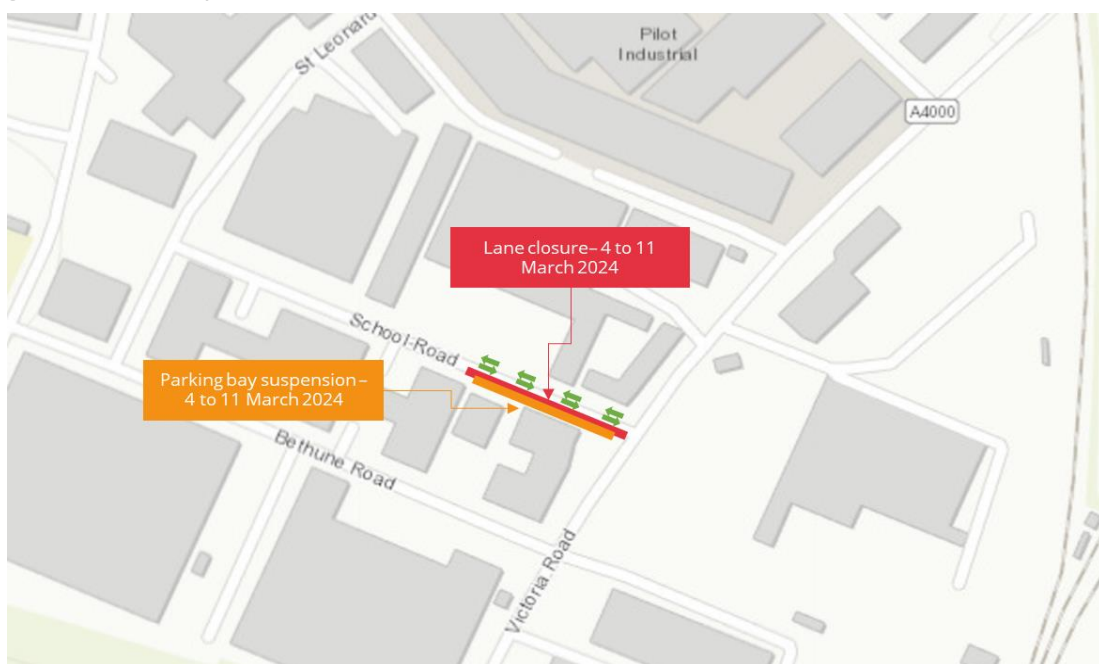
Parking bay suspension on School Road – 19 to 23 February 2024

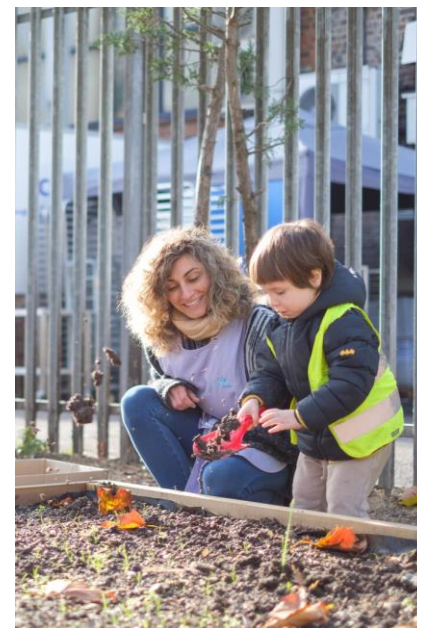
