What we are doing

From 11 March 2024 to 30 June 2024, we are carrying out piling works at our Gate 2 site, in the area west of Breakspear Road South and north of the Chiltern Railways Line.

These works are part of the construction of the eastern portal of the Copthall Tunnel.

We do not expect any noise or vibration to disturbance nearby residents. Monitoring will be in place throughout these works. We will use water sprays to reduce dust generated by construction activities.

We would like to apologise in advance for any disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way.

We will ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum.

Hours of work

Our working hours are Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm, and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

There will be heavy goods vehicle deliveries outside of the core working hours of 8am to 6pm, due to restrictions on movements on motorways to our site on Harvil Road. These deliveries are planned on 1 March and 4 to 8 March.

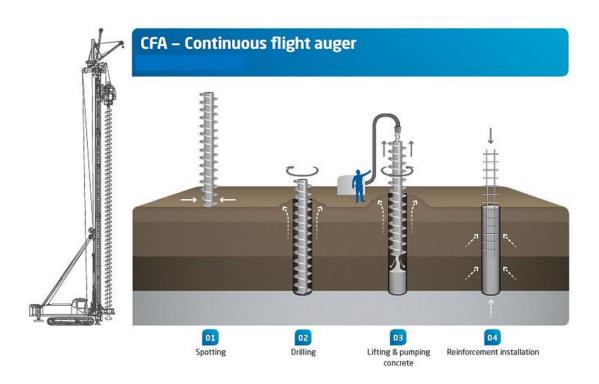
What to expect

During the works, you may notice large construction equipment and machinery in our site including heavy goods vehicles, piling and excavating machinery, cranes, lighting towers and concreting equipment.

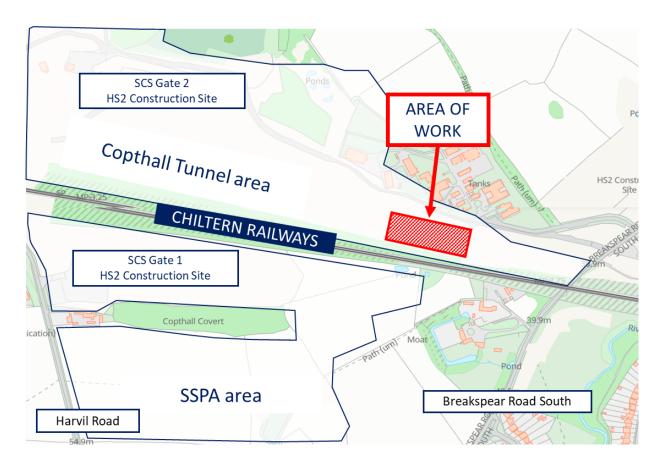
Some works may occur outside of these hours, including concrete works. When work is due to occur outside of core hours, we will notify you beforehand.

Our piling method

The east portal piling will be delivered using Continuous Flight Auger (CFA) techniques. CFA piling is when a continuous auger (hollow stem) is drilled into the ground to the required depth. Once the required depth is achieved, concrete is installed via the piling rig and through the hollow stem auger. The auger is then slowly withdrawn, and reinforced steel cages are instantly installed. This method should not cause any disruption.
