### What are we doing?

As we move to the next phase of construction of the Small Dean Viaduct, there will be a lane closure across several dates on the A413 to facilitate movement of piling rigs to allow the rigs on to our site. During this time, we will be mobilising and demobilising Small Dean Viaduct piling works.

To carry out these works safely, the lane closures will be under a 2-way temporary traffic light system. This is for safety reasons as our operatives will be working in and around the carriage way.

To reduce impact on road users, these traffic lights will be in operation at off-peak times.

# When will these works take place?

These works are scheduled for the daytime (off-peak) between 9:00am - 3pm on the following dates:

- Thursday 7 March
- Wednesday 27 March
- Wednesday 3 April
- Wednesday 10 April
- Monday 15 April

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but works will be completed in or around the set timeframes.


