



## Notice of road closures, Stratton Audley Road, Chetwode

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at [www.hs2inbucksandox.co.uk](http://www.hs2inbucksandox.co.uk).

### What are we doing?

As part of our continued preparatory works for the School End Overbridge, we are now constructing a new permanent access for a local land owner. These works are required to maintain access for the land owner while we build HS2.

The dates of the closure are staggered as these works are being carried out in phases. When our team need to work directly in the carriageway, there will be a full road closure of a section of Stratton Audley Road, by School End.

Our works will include some localised vegetation clearance, the pouring of concrete, surfacing works and the installation of drainage, kerbs and boundary fencing.

### When will these works take place?

A section of Stratton Audley Road, near School End, will be closed with a signed diversion route in place on the following dates:

- Thursday 29 February and Friday 1 March – Daytime closures between 8.30am and 5.30pm
- Monday 15 April to Tuesday 30 April – Full 24 hour road closures
- Monday 6 May to Monday 13 May - Full 24 hour road closures

We will work to reopen the road as soon as possible. Access will be maintained for emergency services with caution.

These works are subject to consents and we will update communities as our works progress.

**A section of Stratton Audley Road by School End will be closed on the following dates:**

- 29 February and 1 March
- 15 April to 30 April
- 6 May to 13 May

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.
