High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Weekend concrete pours

On Saturday(s) 2, 9 and 16 March and Sunday(s) 3, 10 and 17 March 2024 we will be working extended hours at the Canterbury Works site to pour concrete which will create the base slab within the shaft.

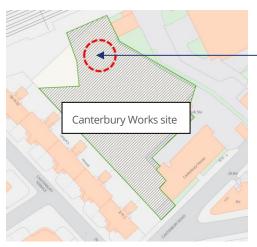
On all Saturdays, we will be pouring concrete to create the base slab within the shaft. The concrete pours must be a continuous uninterrupted process to ensure the structural integrity of the base slab.

On all Sundays, jet washing, and other activities will take place within the shaft.

How will this affect you?

You may see additional vehicles entering and leaving the site. Most work will be below ground, but cranes and a concrete pump will be in use above ground to aid the work.

This work is not expected to be noisy, but you may notice general construction noise and noise from the use of the crane and concrete pump.
