High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Work activities over the Easter weekend

From **Friday 29 March to Monday 1 April 2024** there will be reduced site activity across our sites in line with the Easter weekend working guidelines. Please refer to the map overleaf for site locations.

Victoria Road Crossover Box site (VRCB) and Flat Iron

There will be phased lorry movements between sites to move tunnel segments from Willesden Euroterminal site (WET) to Atlas Road Logistics Tunnel site (ARLT), and then from (ARLT) to Victoria Road Crossover Box site (VRCB)

These movements will operate over the Easter weekend.

Atlas Road Logistics Tunnel site (ARLT)

There are no significant above ground activities during the Easter weekend. The ARLT will be used to move and remove concrete and other materials.

These movements will operate over the Easter weekend.

Willesden Euroterminal site (WET)

The site will finish rail operations at 7am on Friday 29 March. However, train movements and loading will be carried out between 7am and 3:30pm on Saturday 30 March. Normal site operations will resume from 11pm on Monday 1 April.
