



Notice of road closure, A425 Leamington Road, Southam

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We will be undertaking work on the water main, sewer and BT cable diversion works on the A425 Southam Road to enable the construction of the new green tunnel we will be excavating across the carriage way to realigning various utilities.

When these works will take place

A road closure of the A425 Southam Road will be in place, between the B4452 and the B4451, this section of road will be closed 24/7 from **23 March to 12 April 2024**. A signed diversion route will be in place (please see map on page 2), please allow additional time for your journey. There will be additional temporary traffic lights from 10 to 12 April near the polo ground.

We will maintain access to homes and businesses at all times during these works. Also access to properties within the closure for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained.

Our workforce may be on site up to one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

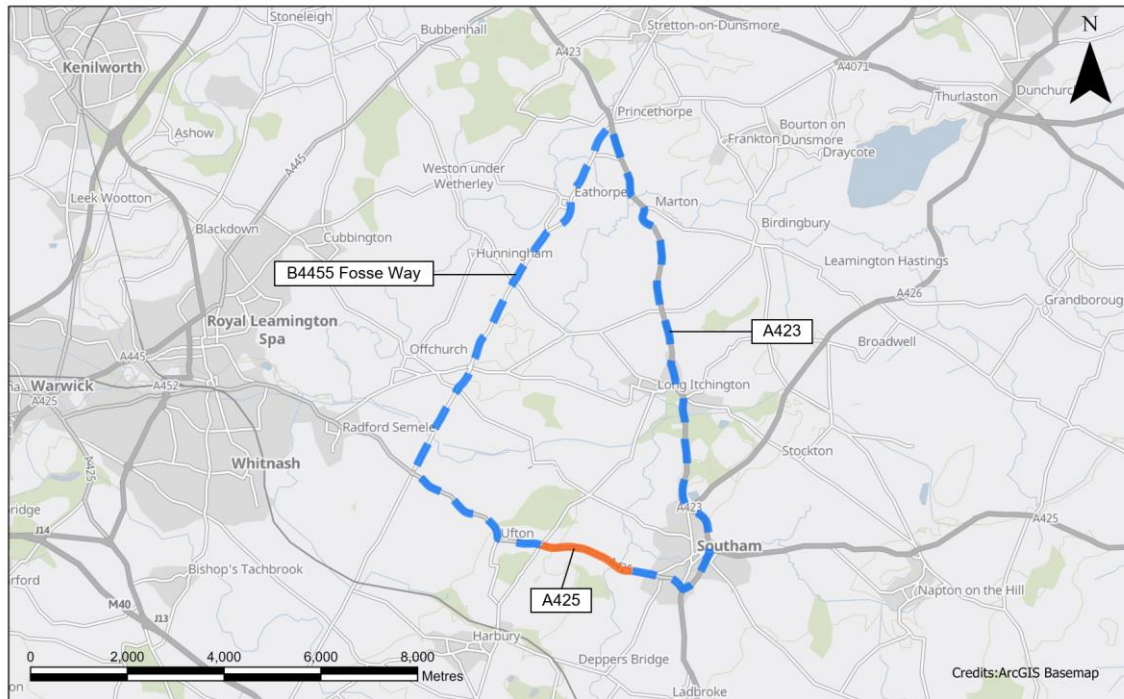

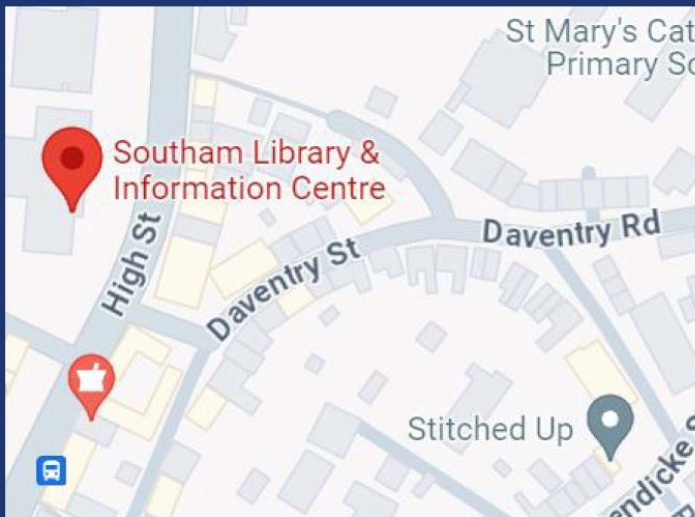
