High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

School Road Sewer Lining Works

We wrote to you in February about sewer lining works in our Flat Iron site and on School Road. We completed the first phase of works on our Flat Iron site in late February.

The next phase of our works on School Road were scheduled from 4 to 11 March. Due to overnight staff availability, the works on School Road will now take place from 11 to 15 March.

We will be using a machinery to lift and insert a new liner into the existing sewer system via manholes in the road.

These works will take place overnight, between 7pm to 7am. We do not expect these works to cause any major noise disruption.

We will use noise reducing barriers where possible, to help minimise any noise disruption to the local community and work as efficiently as possible whilst keeping our work areas safe and tidy.

How this might affect you

To ensure the safety of the public and our staff, temporary changes will be in place on School Road overnight including a temporary lane closure and parking bay suspensions. You will still be able to drive along School Road.

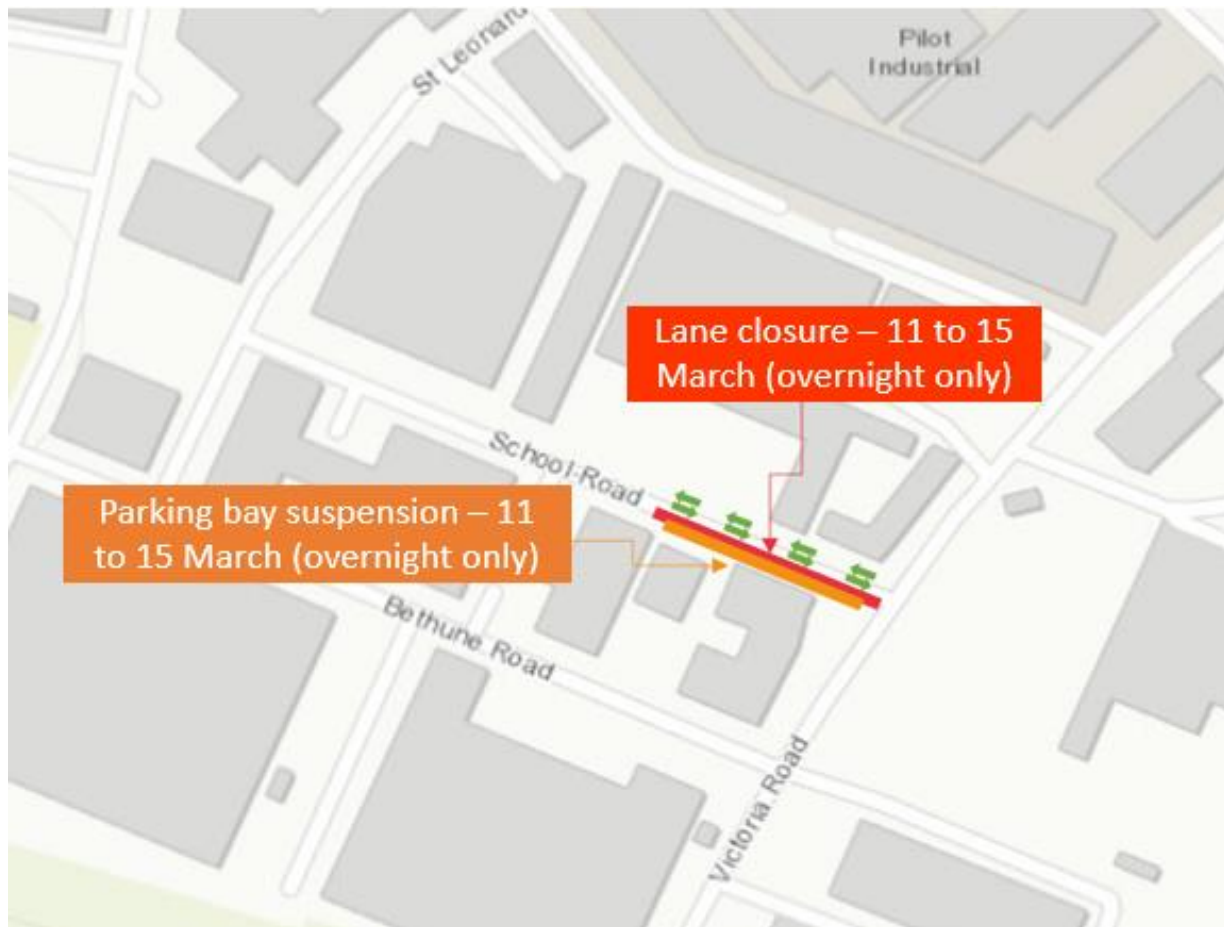
