## What we are doing – Delay to permanent wall build

We wrote to you on 6 March 2024, to let you know that we would be starting the next phase of works to build our permanent wall on the western boundary of the South Ruislip site.

The construction of the new wall along the western boundary is delayed due to a redesign of the wall foundations. We'll need to extend the western boundary so that we can accommodate the existing site drainage. **Work should restart in August 2024** and will be intermittent with other works on site. Regular updates will be provided.

We would like to apologise for the delay and for any disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way. We will ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum and that regular updates are provided.

## How the works might affect you

You may experience increased construction noise during these works. Noise and vibration monitoring will be in place throughout these works. We will use water mists to reduce dust generated by our construction activities.
