

Notice of lane closures on A413, Little Missenden, Buckinghamshire, for survey works and grass strimming

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This notice is to inform you of temporary lane closures on the A413, in Little Missenden, to undertake strimming of vegetation and surveys for ground monitoring during the construction of the Chiltern Tunnel.


How will these works affect you?

We will close a short single lane section of the northbound and southbound A413 dual carriageways to facilitate surveys and trim vegetation on the central reservation. Traffic management will be installed to direct traffic during the works. The lane closures will occur from 9.30am to 3:30pm from Monday 25 to Thursday 28 March 2024.

What will we be doing?

A small team will be present in the closed section undertaking surveys and grass strimming on the central reservation.

To do this safely a small section of the northbound and southbound lanes on the A413 will be temporarily closed until these works are completed.

Duration of works

These works will take place on Monday 25 March to Thursday 28 March 9.30am to 3.30pm

What to expect

Single lane closures of a short section of A413 dual carriageway both north and southbound between Amersham and Great Missenden

Operatives visible and working in the area

What we will do

Fully signed traffic management will be in place

Keep one lane in either direction open at all times

We will reopen the lanes as soon as we are able to do so

We will keep you updated if plans change
