High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We will be carrying out site boundary works at Cubbington, it's for the advance works ahead of earthwork embankment construction. To carry out the works safely, we will need to close Coventry Road.

When these works will take place

The closure will be in place on 8 April 2024, from 9.30am to 3.30pm.

A fully signposted diversion will be in place during the closure with access to all properties maintained throughout. Coventry Road will remain open for pedestrians and cyclists. Our workforce may be on site up to one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

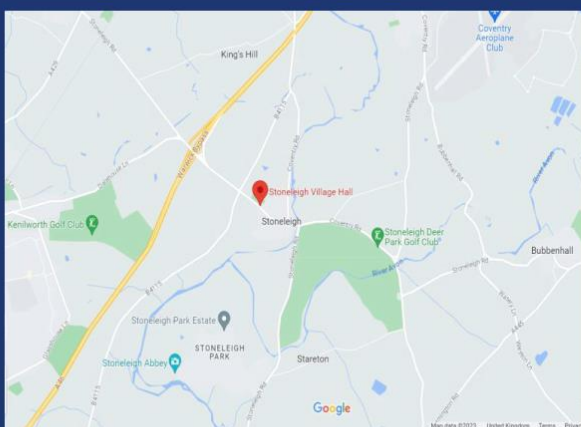

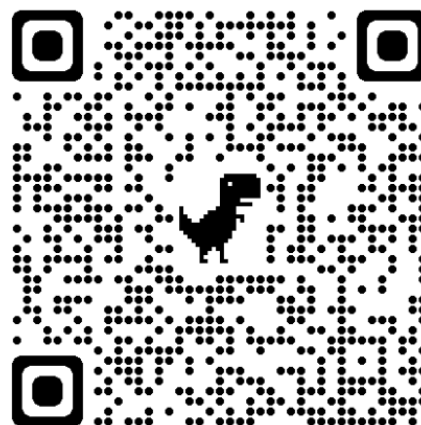
