## Notification about railway work in the Euston Station area:

Work is continuing to bring some of the projects for High Speed 2 (HS2) in the Euston area to a safe stop, whilst other vital work that needs to continue in preparation for HS2 will continue. To keep our staff safe, we may need to work at times that cause the least disruption to train services and passengers which can include weeknights and weekends. We're sorry if our work disturbs you and we will make every effort to reduce disturbance where we can. We'll put noise barriers up where it is safe to do so, use silenced generators and have continuous noise monitoring to ensure that noise levels are kept within agreed limits. Our staff will also be regularly briefed on the importance of working responsibly in the local community.

Other work in your area:

Throughout April – May, SCS JV will be preparing to pause works from June 2024. This will involve removal of large machinery and securing the site.

MDjv work to construct a new power substation for London Underground (adjacent to Stephenson Way) is ongoing until 2026.

Work to open a new interim taxi rank in Euston's eastern gardens area continues and is expected to open this year. Further communication about the open date will be issued at a later date.
