High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As part of the ongoing work, we will be carrying out trial holes and GPR surveys. To carry this work out safely and with minimal disruption, we will need to put in place a closure on Fosse Way. A clearly signposted diversion route will be in place for the duration of the works.

When will these works be taking place?

The closure will be in place on **29 April to 3 May 2024** between **9.30am and 3.30pm**, to minimise disruption to peak traffic. Access to properties, for pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained while the works are being carried out.
