TUNNEL WALL REPAIR WORK

Network Rail is due to start work near your property, and I wanted to give you some more information about the times we will be working and what the work will involve. We apologise for the late notice of these works.

We will be working near you repairing the brickwork on one of the walls above our tunnel where Gloucester Avenue meets Oval Road, as well as resurfacing the nearby area. This will help maintain the safety of the railway for our passengers into the future.

To complete these works, we will be using small generators, hand tools, small power tools, and battery lights. This will create a small amount of noise disruption, but our team will do what they can to keep noise to a minimum.

We are currently scheduled to carry out work on the below dates, but this is subject to change. If there are any changes, we will send you another letter to let you know.

- **08:00 Monday 25 March 2024 until 16:00 Thursday 28 March 2024 (Setting up site)**
- **24/7 continuous working – Friday 29 March 2024 until Monday 1 April 2024 (Physical works with tools and equipment)**
- **Resurfacing works 08:00 Tuesday 2 April 2024 until 16:00 Friday 19 April 2024**

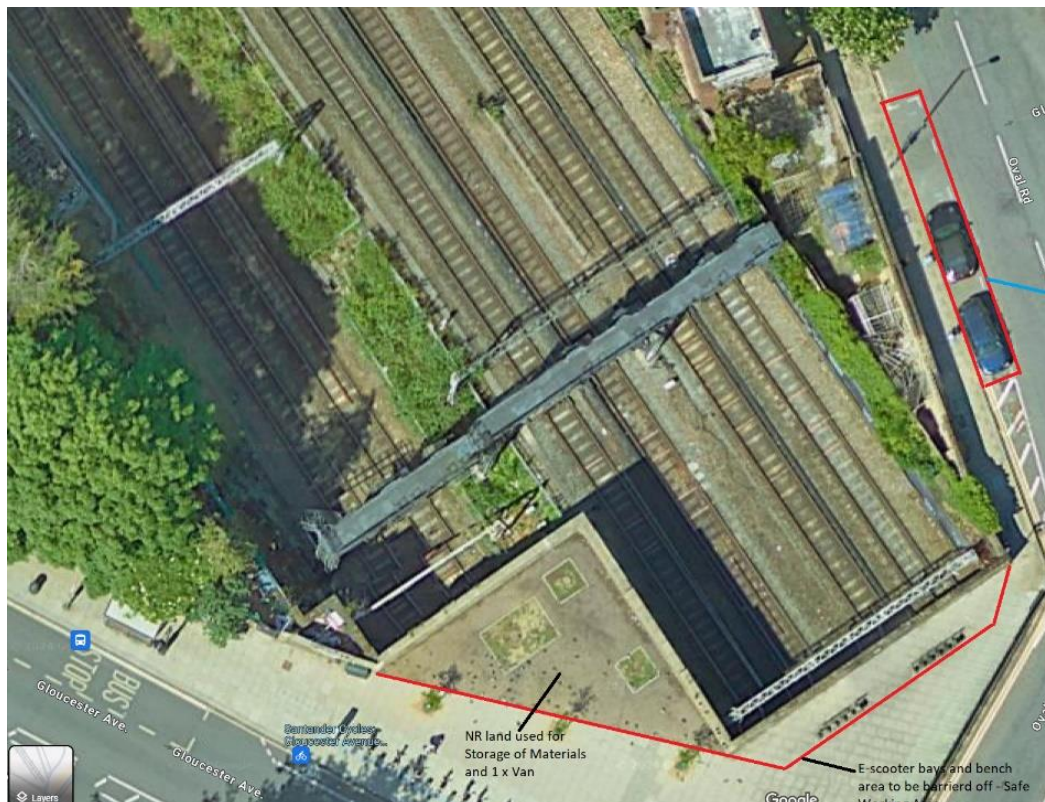
As we set up the site and carry out the repairs, the area by the wall will be segregated off and materials will be stored there. We will also need to put a barrier around the benches where Gloucester Avenue meets Oval Road to allow for a safe working area. There will still be sufficient space for pushchairs and wheelchairs to pass.
