This look ahead covers HS2 works in Brent and Ealing to build four vent shafts and the HS2 London tunnels. It also covers associated activities such as utility and bridge surveys and protection works along the HS2 London tunnels route. For information around Old Oak Common station, please see our Old Oak and North Acton look ahead.

The document includes:

- A forward look of construction activities planned in the next three months; and
- Works to be aware of that will take place in the next 12 months, but may not yet have been confirmed.

Location 1 Canterbury Works site	March to July 2024	<ul> <li>Ongoing works at our Canterbury Works site during this period include:</li> <li>Works to build the ventilation shaft including base slab waterproofing and reinforced concrete lining works; and</li> <li>Preparation of the site for the safe stop period.</li> </ul>
Various locations, Brent	March to May 2024	We will continue to carry out utility surveys and protection works in various locations along the HS2 tunnel route. We are preparing to carry out utility protection works on Kilburn High Road.

Location 1 Canterbury Works site	Summer 2024 to summer 2025	During summer we will be preparing the site for a safe stop period. Site work activities will be brought to a safe pause from autumn 2024 following the Transport Secretary announcement.
		During the safe stop period the Canterbury Works site will have 24/7 security in place as well as various personnel in attendance for ongoing monitoring of the site and adjacent Network Rail infrastructure. Various maintenance works may take place when required.
		Site work activities are planned to restart from spring to summer 2025. We will write to local communities in advance of works restarting.
Various locations,	Summer 2024 to summer 2025	We will carry out utility surveys and protection work in various locations along the HS2 tunnel route.
Brent		During summer 2024, we are planning to carry out utility protection works on Kilburn High Road.
		Further details and dates for any utility and bridge protection works remain subject to ongoing surveys and design work.



		<ul> <li>Work to build sprayed concrete lining adits (horizontal passages) that will connect the HS2 tunnels;</li> <li>Removal of water from the ground as the shaft is constructed;</li> <li>Network Rail track maintenance works every three months; and</li> <li>Work to build the headhouse (the building that sits on top of the ventilation shaft) base slab concrete and piling works.</li> </ul>
Location 2 Greenford Road	March to May 2024	<ul> <li>Completion of utility works on Greenford Road during this period include:</li> <li>Excavation;</li> <li>Replacement of the gas and water mains;</li> <li>Traffic management on Greenford Road includes a lane closure, temporary traffic lights and pedestrian crossing and footpath diversions; and</li> <li>Reinstatement of the site.</li> </ul>



Location 2 Eastcote Lane	March to May 2024	<ul> <li>Gas and water main replacement works on Eastcote Lane, including:</li> <li>Excavation works;</li> <li>Installation of a temporary site compound on Moat Farm Road;</li> <li>Installation of a temporary gas pipe above the ground;</li> </ul>

		<ul> <li>Partial road closure on Eastcote Lane at the junction with Eastcote Lane North to access the gas mains during the works;</li> <li>Replacement of the gas and water mains; and</li> <li>Reinstatement of the road.</li> </ul>

Location 1 Mandeville Road site	Summer 2024 to summer 2025	<ul> <li>Works planned at our Mandeville Road site during this period include:</li> <li>Ongoing construction of the main shaft and satellite shaft including internal concrete structures;</li> <li>Works to build the headhouse (the building that sits on top of the ventilation shaft) including reinforced concrete structures and foundations;</li> <li>Installation of secondary vehicle access point to site – details of these works remain subject to confirmation. Further information will be provided to the local community; and</li> <li>Landscaping works within the site compound.</li> </ul>
Various locations in Ealing	Summer 2024 to summer 2025	<ul> <li>We will be carrying out the following works at various locations in Ealing following the progress of our tunnel boring machines building the HS2 London tunnels.</li> <li>Surveys of roads including Mandeville Road, Carr Road and Eastcote Lane;</li> <li>Borehole investigations and decommissioning at locations along the HS2 London tunnels route; and</li> </ul>

 Surveys, monitoring and protection works for some structures along the HS2 London tunnels route.

# **Respecting People, Respecting Places**

Having listened to feedback from communities and stakeholders, we have refreshed our Community Engagement Strategy. <u>'Respecting People, Respecting Places'</u> highlights how we will always try to do the right thing and reduce disruption to the lives of local people as much as we can during the planning and building of the railway.

- **Consulting**: Formally consult with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b (we now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a)

## Our commitments to you

#### **Informing**

- We will tell you about HS2 works in your area.
- We have local community websites and newsletters with regular information and updates about our work in your area.
- We have local community teams who know your area. They will hold local events and run projects to keep you informed.

#### **Involving**

- We will involve you in opportunities to benefit and learn as we build HS2 including jobs, skills, education, employment and funding.
- We will ask you about the design of specific parts of the railway.

#### Responding

- Our dedicated HS2 Helpdesk is available 24 hours a day, every day of the year, to help with any questions or concerns you have about HS2 or our work.
- If things go wrong, we have a complaints process and a dedicated complaints team.
- An independent Construction Commissioner monitors how we manage and deal with complaints.

#### **Consulting**

- We will hold formal consultations with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b of HS2.
- We now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a. This means we will only formally consult on this part of HS2 when we need permission to do things that fall outside the terms of the legislation agreed by Parliament.

We are committed to keeping you informed about work on HS2. This includes ensuring you know what to expect and when to expect it, as well as how we can help.
