



# Notice of road closure Stonebridge Lane, near Offchurch

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

## The work we will be doing.

We will be carrying out trial hole and gas utilities surveys. To do this work safely with minimal disruption, we will need to put in place a closure on Stonebridge Lane. We will have a diversion in place, however due to the low bridge on the route, this diversion is only suitable for vehicles under 4.2m high. **All vehicles over 4.2m will need to make alternative arrangements.**

## When will these works be taking place?

Stonebridge Lane will be closed from **22 to 26 April 2024** to minimise disruption during peak time the closure will be between **9.30am and 3.30pm**.

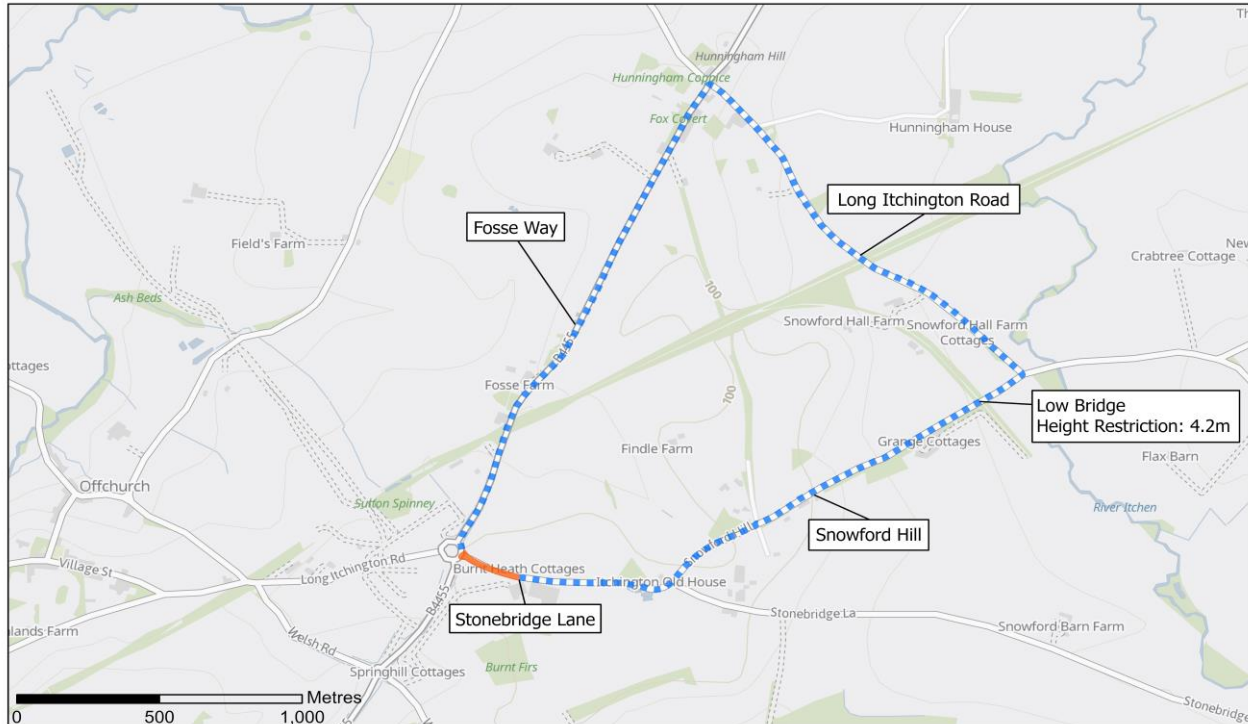

### Stonebridge Lane closure and diversion map

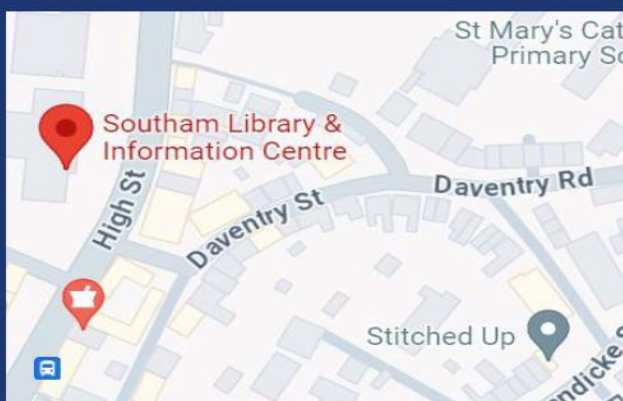
