



# Spring Update: Works at Willesden Euroterminal site

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We continue to operate the Willesden Euroterminal site on a 24/7 shift pattern. At the site, we manage the reception and removal of excavated materials, ensure timely delivery of tunnel segments, and conduct essential maintenance tasks.

## Rail Activities

We are currently managing rail activity for up to 20 train departures of excavated material a week, as well as receiving and managing six trains a week carrying tunnel segments.

As the tunnelling programme progresses, we expect from April 2024 to manage rail activity for up to 35 train departures of excavated material a week, as well as continued delivery of the tunnel segment by rail.

This means that from April 2024 you may experience an increase in site activity and associated noise from the Willesden Euroterminal site.

When possible, we will prioritise loading operations by day to minimise disruption. But as demand increases, loading will occur during the day and night shifts.

We will continue to brief our operatives to use best practice methods to reduce disruption and continue to review our working practices to ensure that our works are carried out in ways that will reduce disruption as much as it is feasibly possible.

Night operatives will also be briefed prior to the start of shift to remind them to be mindful of our neighbours whilst they work.
