What are we doing?

In preparation for our A41 realignment works, we will be undertaking utility works to allow BT to connect communication cables between two chambers on the A41, near Waddesdon.

As we are working around the carriageway, these works will necessitate a lane closure with traffic management. There will be 4-way traffic lights along the A41 and at the junctions of Blackgrove Road and Waddesdon Hill.

To reduce impact on road users, the traffic lights will be in operation at off-peak hours and access will be maintained for residents along the A41.

When will these works take place?

• Thursday 9 May 9am - 3pm

Every effort will be made to complete these works within one daytime closure.

However, we have planned contingency dates if the works are not completed on 9 May for the following date:

• Friday 10 May 9am - 3pm

These dates are subject to change due to ground conditions but will be completed in or around the anticipated time schedules.



Where will the lane closure be located?

The map below, shows the location of the lane closure. There will be a 4-way traffic light system in place on Thursday 9 May between the hours 9am – 3pm.

Are there any more works on the A41?


Yes, one of our main sections of work in Aylesbury in re-aligning the A41 to allow for the HS2 trace to run alongside the road. From now until Summer 2024, we will have a programme of works which will provide a phased approach to opening the new alignment to the public. This will include closures on Blackgrove Road and the A41 at separate times. We will communicate this out to the public in due course.

What will the A41 re-alignment look like?

The map shown illustrates the proposed new alignment of the A41.

The new road will sweep to the east of the existing road and connect to Blackgrove Road with a new roundabout. There will be a section of Blackgrove road that will be a bridge which will carry traffic over the HS2 rail line. The existing A41 will be narrowed and used for local access only.

When the new alignment is completed, the temporary roundabout that was installed by the compound will be removed.
