High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.


UPDATE - We previously contacted you to advise that we would be working on Saturday nights from 14 January until 5 May. Unfortunately, some of our planned railway possessions were cancelled by Network Rail so that they could undertake essential work. As such we are likely to require a further overnight possession on 11 May to install the remaining eight beams.

The work we will be doing

You may be aware that the new railway line will cross over the West Coast Main Line just south of Berkswell Railway Station. BBV have been building an overbridge in the area known as Carol Green from our construction compound located off Truggist Lane.

Progress on the bridge is limited by the constraints of working near an operational railway line and there are some works that can only be completed when the railway is closed overnight. From 14 January 2024 until 11 May 2024 our operatives will be using a crane to lift precast beams on to the structure on Saturday nights into the early hours of Sunday morning. We don't envisage this work to be particularly noisy but there will be some site activity requiring lighting at night. The beams will be delivered during the day via our haul road access off Hallmeadow Road roundabout.
