High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We will be carrying out construction works to move the access to our compound on the Coventry Road. This will enable us to progress construction of Coventry Road Overbridge and connecting embankments. To carry out these works safely we will temporarily close a section of Coventry Road and put a diversion in place.

The traffic management that will be in operation

We will close a section of Coventry Road between 13 May to 24 May. The closure will be in place from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday. Outside of these hours temporary two-way traffic lights will be in operation overnight and at weekends, to reduce the impact on local communities.

There will be a signed diversion route in place during the closure and access to properties will be maintained.

We will be hosting local public drop-in events in your area to share project updates and answer any questions you may have about the ongoing works.

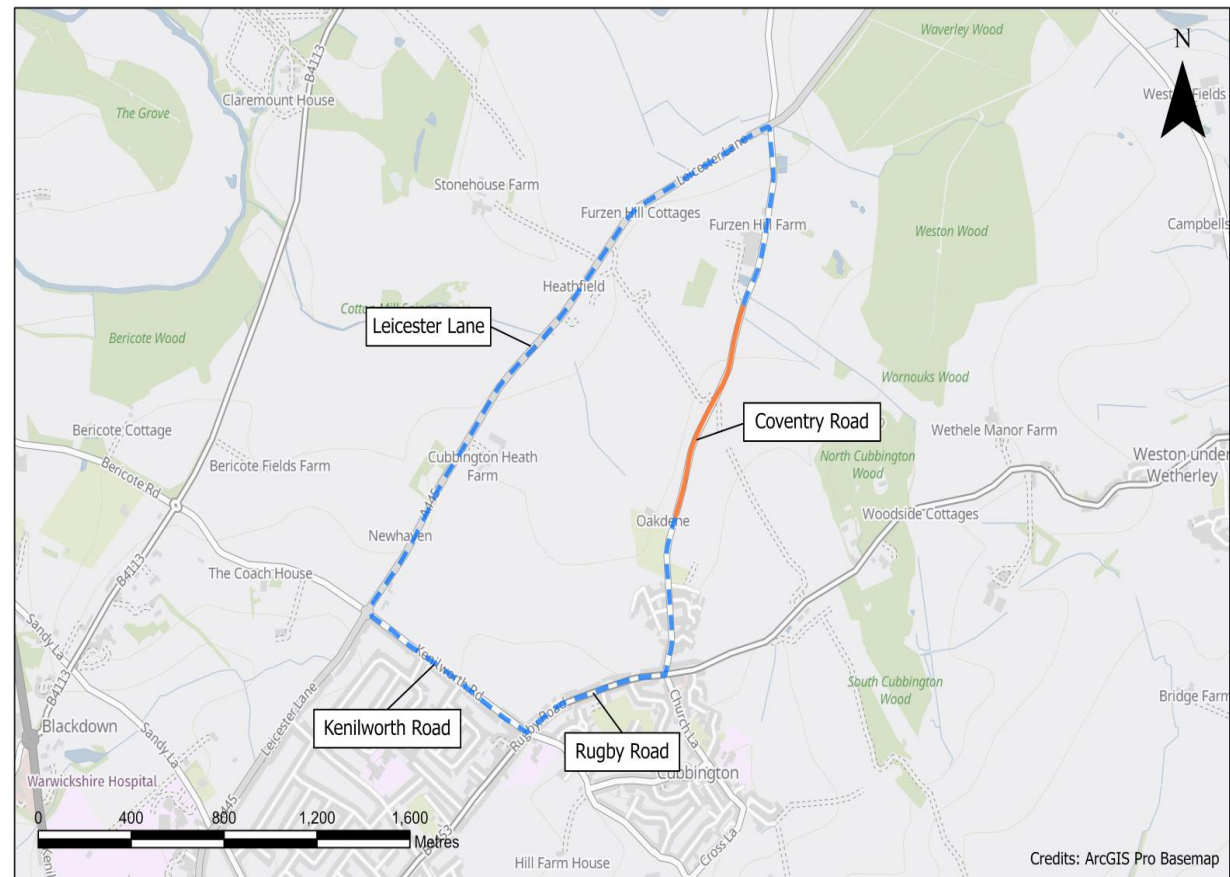

— Lane closure

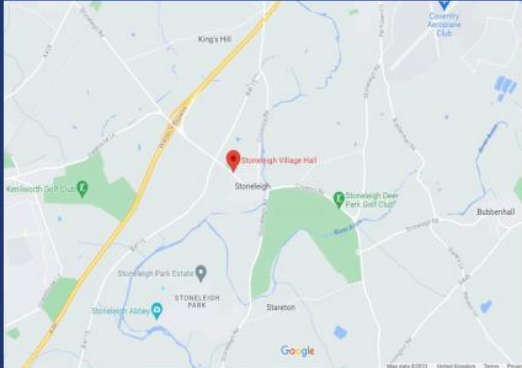
