High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This notice is to inform you that we are carrying out remedial works to the public right of way in Little Missenden.

What are we doing?

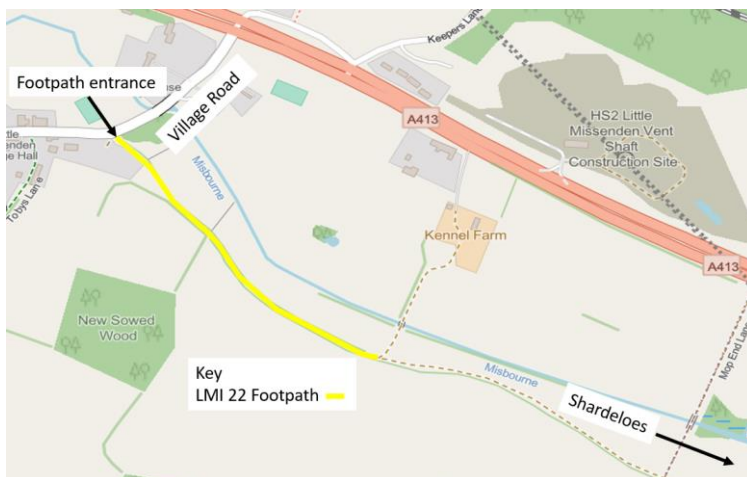
A survey has identified following previous works in the area there has been some minor damage to the public right of way, LMI 22, which is located just off Village Road, Little Missenden. We will be working in the area to rectify this across three days in May.

How will this affect me?

Operatives will be working in the area between the hours of:

- 9am to 5pm
- From 6 to 8 May

Whilst the footpath will remain open during our works, we would like to remind the public to proceed with caution. Vehicular access to Kennel Farm will be maintained. Our plant and machinery will also use the lane to access works.
