



Notice of overnight road closure - Coleshill Heath Road – Chelmsley Wood

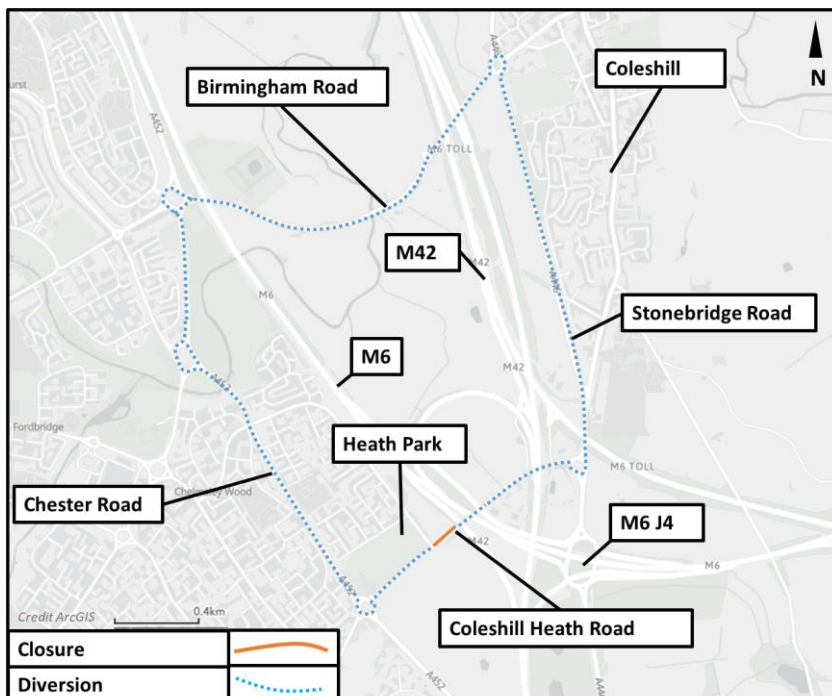

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

The new railway will be elevated on an embankment and bridge structure as it passes over Coleshill Heath Road. We will shortly be commencing sheet piling works either side of the carriageway which will enable us to build the bridge and maintain the structural integrity of the existing road. Before commencing this work, we will need to install temporary safety barriers either side of the road to protect all road users and our workforce. In order to do this we will need to close the road for two nights. The road will be closed at 8pm on 23 May and will reopen at 6am on 24 May. We will then close the road again at 8pm on 24 May and re-open at 6am on 25 May. **See the map below**
