



Notice of emergency road closure – A452 Chester Road – Marston Green

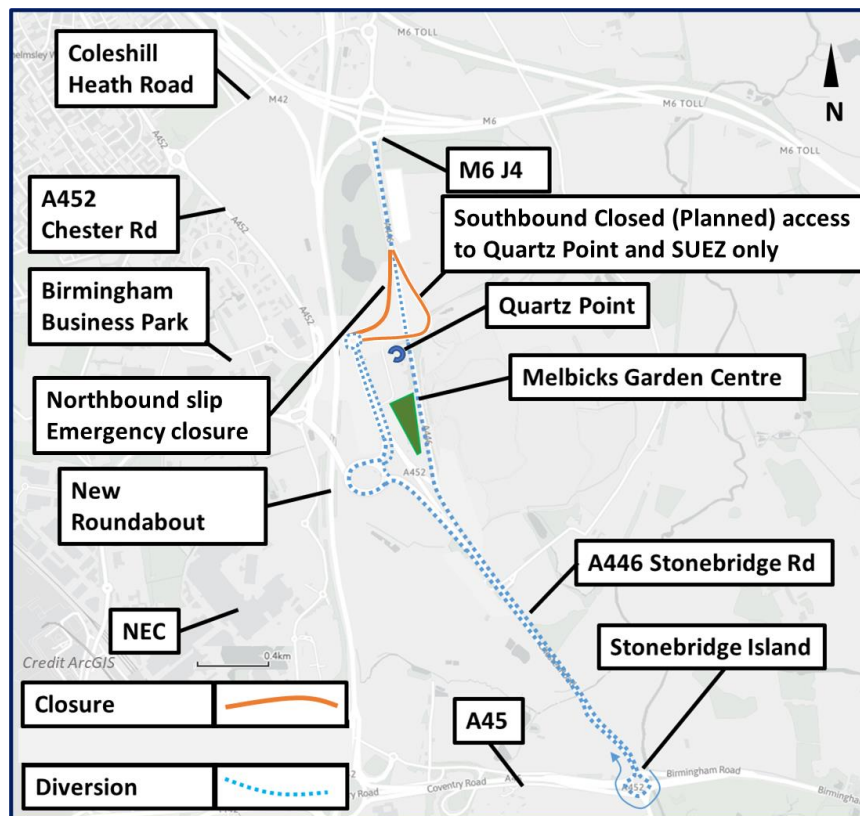

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

You may be aware that BBV have been remodelling the junction of the A446 and A452 in the area around Birmingham Business Park. This work is now largely complete with only remedial work to complete. Over the weekend part of the carriageway was damaged by machinery fire. In order to repair this damage, the northbound slip road from the A452 to the A446 will need to be closed for one night on from 9pm on 9 April until 6am on 10 April. Please note that there is an existing planned closure on the southbound slip road.
