High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Utility Works on 'lower' Kilburn High Road

We recently wrote to you in February 2024 about planned utility works on Kilburn High Road during the summer. These works are scheduled to take place from **13 May until 30 August 2024**.

We will be carrying out works to protect and upgrade the main gas pipe below the lower end of Kilburn High Road between Greville Road and Oxford Road. We will be digging a number of trenches along the road to reach the depth of the main gas pipe. The existing metal gas pipe will be replaced with polyethylene (plastic).

How this might affect you

To ensure the safety of the public and our staff, temporary changes will be in place on the lower end of Kilburn High Road and surrounding roads in phases (shown on the following page).

During all phases there will be:

- Lane closures in place on Kilburn High Road
- Partial road closures on Oxford Road and Greville Road
- Bus stop suspensions on Kilburn High Road (Stop W and X)
- Parking bay suspensions on Oxford Road and Greville Road
- Clearly signed diversion routes for vehicles and pedestrians

Access to businesses in the area will be maintained at all times.

The works will take place between 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays. In July, we will be required to undertake extended weekend working (see overleaf).

We will use noise reducing barriers where possible to help minimise any noise disruption to the local community, working as efficiently as possible whilst keeping our work areas safe and tidy.

Your utility services will not be affected during this time.

8am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays

We may be on site for an hour before the start and/or end of each shift

During phase two weekend working, staff will work 8am to 6pm

Parking suspensions Oxford Road and Greville Road
