Vegetation clearance and monitoring installation

From **13 May to 16 June**, we will trim vegetation next to the railway tracks between Pervale and Northolt Stations. These works will take place overnight between 12am and 6am.

From **15 May to 23 June**, we will install monitoring equipment in the same area. This will also take place overnight when trains are not running. We will use the monitoring equipment to monitor the railway tracks when we build the HS2 tunnels in this area.
