



Notice of weekend road closures, A361, Chipping Warden

What are we doing?

We are continuing to prepare the A361 in Chipping Warden for the permanent realignment of the highway over the Chipping Warden Green Tunnel.

In May we will be moving the utilities which run near and under the existing road, just north of the village. We will also be carrying out additional work in the verges of the A361. This is in preparation for the installation of safety barriers, which will allow our workforce to start building the new section of highway.

A section of the A361 will require two weekend closures to complete this work safely. This will be followed by a period of traffic lights at the same location, incorporating the EKFB compound traffic lights.

When will these works take place?

A361 weekend road closures:

- 8pm on Friday 10 May to 6am on Monday 13 May 2024
- 8pm on Friday 17 May to 6am on Monday 20 May 2024

With a contingency weekend planned from 8pm on Friday 31 May to 6am on Monday 3 June 2024, if required.

Traffic lights from Mondays to Fridays, from 20 May to 31 May, 24 hours a day (excluding Bank Holiday Monday).

This work is subject to approvals from the local authority and the dates of the work may change.

Duration of works

Weekend road closures, from 8pm on Friday evening to 6am on Monday morning:

10 to 13 May and

17 to 20 May 2024.

Traffic lights from 20 May to 31 May, 24 hours a day.

Construction work will take place through this closure period, including early mornings and evenings.

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Our workforce in and near the road during the road closures and traffic management.

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

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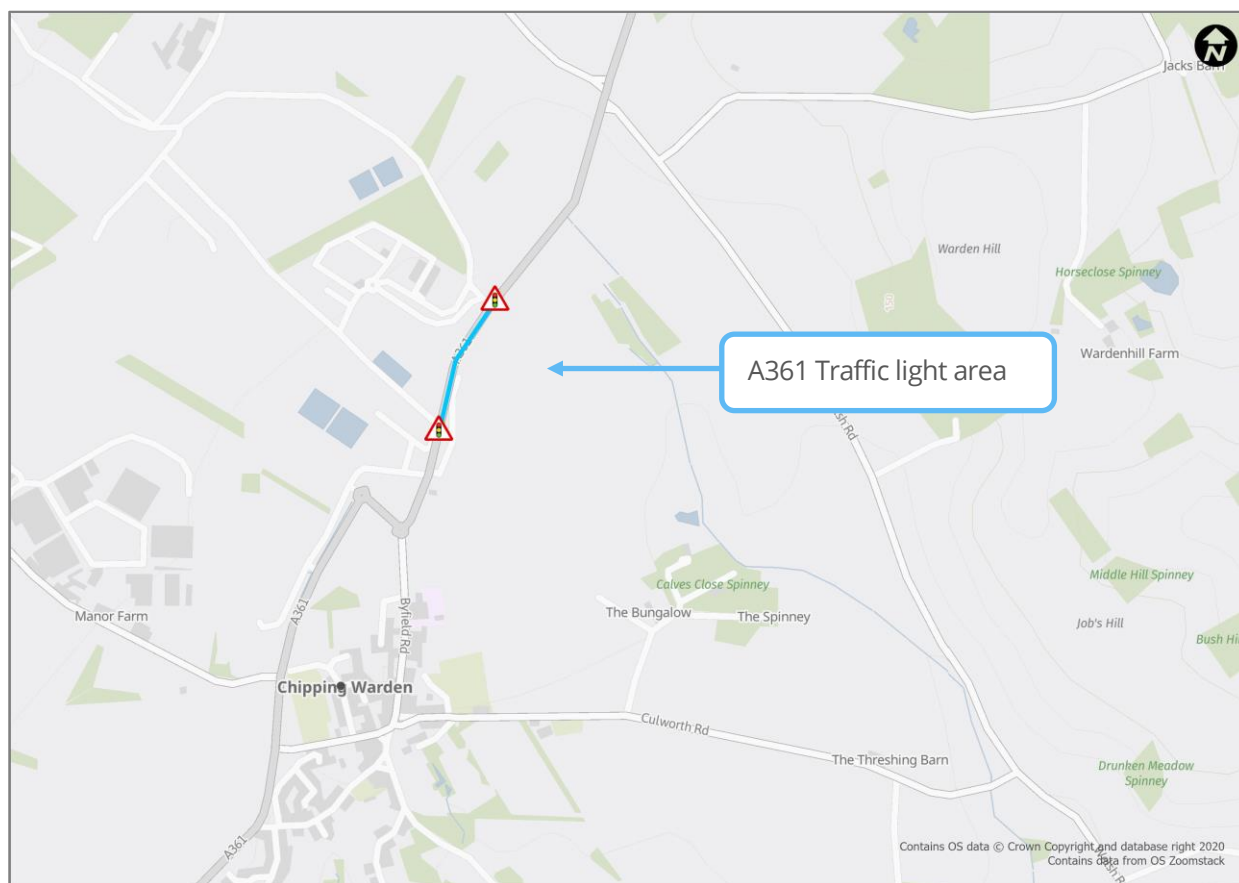
